
Location: Juba

Scope of responsibilities:

Organizing and supervising the daily supply chair activities and the teams associated, in the coordination or project level, according to MSF protocols and standards in order to ensure the optimal running of the mission

Main tasks:

- Supervising and organizing the daily activities of the procurement team, including Data processing officer and purchasers, and ensuring they perform the tasks linked to their role
- Being responsible for the order, purchase, management in the coordination, monitoring and ensuring an efficient implementation of the overall daily supply chain activities
- Monitoring and ensuring a smooth-running procurement department and the respect of the implemented supply procedures, proposing adjustments where needed.
- Being responsible for the supply database and the correct filing and archiving of the supply documentation in order to guarantee the availability and the coherence of supply data
- Communicating with customers, keeping them up to date concerning their orders status (BO confirmation) and prioritizing procurement and transport according to their needs
- Collecting claims from the field, analysing causes and making corrective actions.
- In collaboration with the Supply manager and in coordination with the HR department, supervising the associated processes (recruitment, training/induction, briefing/debriefing, evaluation, potential detection, development and communication) of the staff under his/her responsibility in order to ensure both the sizing and the amount of knowledge required
- Informing the Supply Manager in case of any major issue and draws-up all required reporting, to keep updated and reliable information that will help in decision-making
- Performing any other tasks within the scope of his role, as directed by supervision and according to the needs of the mission
- Standardization of processes and procedures of supply chain management: Implement and respect order chronograms for local, regional and international orders; ensure updated LSL with price and source list; perform weekly backorder analysis;
- Work with the order processing officer on procurement efforts to ensure order consolidation, purchase of the
 correct items from validated suppliers with the right quality. Ensure compliance with the procurement process and
 validation table.
- Ensure UF data quality and accuracy through constant monitoring and routine checks. Ensuring that all orders, deliveries and data concerning stocks are processed through UF according to established procedures.
- Ensure that appropriate documentation have been received and validated for all activities from order placement, data entry, order processing receptions and deliveries in line with MSF policy and validation table.
- Ensure that archiving is done according to MSF standard archiving procedure.
- Provide coaching and training for team members to enhance capacity. Ensure job descriptions are updated and SMART objectives are set and appraisals are conducted for each team member.
- Ensure sourcing of goods is in accordance to MSF sourcing stratey.
- Supervise daily activities of purchasing officers to ensure timely order processing and adherance to MSF procurement standards.
- Ensure accurate order status is communicated to all requestors on a weekly basis.





- In collaboration with all the local, regional and European centers, ensure orders are accurately placed and delivered as requested.
- Support the intersectional procurment manager to identify suppliers, monitor and evaluate their performance on a quarterly basis
- Reporting on a monthly basis activities in the procurment department.
