Key Responsibilities:

- · Conduct training and supervision of SWCs with guidelines based on existing SWC Model/approach
- Assist field staff/Local WASH facilitators in the supervision of SWCs.
- Assist in conducting WASH surveys following approved survey protocol.
- Conduct monitoring of WASH program and report areas of concern or problems to WASH Manager.
- Ensure that the project is properly implemented and monitored through frequent field monitoring.
- Prepare weekly, monthly and Detail Implementation Project action plans of project activities related to WASH, including checklist for assessments, monitoring, review and evaluation of project activities.
- Represent Amref in WASH coordination meetings at County levels whenever necessary
- Take a lead role to represent Amref Health Africa in all fora and ensure coordination with other partners and relevant government sector offices regarding WASH in the project areas
- · Coordinate with other managers in order to manage the project, supervise the project by working closely with the technical team to ensure quality of interventions and on timely completion of activities
