Organizational Context

The incumbent is responsible for maintenance, repair, overhaul, and rebuilding of diesel generators and other electrical appliances within the premises of UNHCR. S/he is also expected to apply and ensure adherence to safety programmes related to the safe operation of air-conditioning and refrigeration installations, electrical systems, generating sets or power tools and equipment of the building and maintenance trade.

Duties and Responsibilities

Under the overall supervision of Protection Officer, the incumbent performs the following duties:

- Under the supervision of the Power and Infrastructure officer, a building service assistant (plumber/carpenter) is to install, repair and maintain pipes, valves, fittings, drainage systems, and fixtures in office and residential structures.
- Collaborate with the generator contractors, electricians, and other construction professionals.
- Follow building plans and blueprints.
- Respond to, diagnose, and resolve plumbing emergencies.
- Perform routine inspection of plumbing and drainage systems.

- Light construction, carpentry, painting, plastering, flooring, ceiling, and electrical work as required
- Conduct repair work and installations of doors, windows, drywall, cabinets, stairs, and other fixtures as required.
- Ability to assess the quality of woodwork and materials.
- Ability to operate tools, machines, and other equipment's.
- Perform other related duties as required.
