BACKGROUND:

African Parks is a non-profit conservation organization that takes on the complete responsibility for the rehabilitation and long-term management of national parks in partnership with governments and local communities. We currently manage 22 national parks and protected areas in 12 countries covering over 20 million hectares in: Angola, Benin, Central African Republic, Chad, the Democratic Republic of Congo, Malawi, Mozambique, Republic of Congo, Rwanda, Zambia, Zimbabwe and South Sudan.

Boma and Bandingilo National Parks are located in South Sudan's equatorial region with a combined area of 30, 000 KM ². The parks host the largest wildlife migration in Africa that covers over 120,000 KM², and provides habitat for large populations of white eared kob, tiang, mongalla gazelle and bohor reedbuck.

JOB OVERVIEW:

The Mason will be responsible for constructing, maintaining, and repairing structures made of brick, stone, or concrete. This includes laying bricks, building walls, and other masonry work as required by the project.

MAIN ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Perform masonry work, including laying bricks, blocks, and stones to construct walls, foundations, and other structures.
- Repair and maintain existing masonry structures.
- Mix mortar and other materials needed for masonry work.
- Collaborate with other construction staff to ensure projects are completed according to specifications.
- Adhere to safety protocols and guidelines during all masonry work.
