Job Overview

Under the direct supervision of the Programs Officer, The Reproductive Health Officer implements the reproductive health related activities. S/He will conduct evidence-based advocacy for incorporating adolescents and youth SRH needs in South Sudan laws, policies, and programs. S/He will contribute to increased utilization of quality integrated HIV/GBV/SRHR services in the target locations in South Sudan and improved provision of quality integrated HIV/GBV and SRHR services.

Duties and Responsibilities

Technical

- Spearhead the implementation of integrated GBV/SRH/HIV service provision and prevention activities through targeted centers and Communities.
- Coordinate family and reproductive health care activities, including family planning (FP) activities
- Provide technical assistance for the implementation of FP/RH interventions
- Support demand-generation interventions for family planning, STI/HIV prevention, and SRHR-GBV services including engagement with faith-based organizations and cultural leaders
- Organize and conduct integrated Sexual Reproductive Health and Gender Based Violence camps outreaches targeting youth in the project area.
- Coordinate awareness raising, before and during integrated SRHR service delivery to mobilize the communities for services.
- Ensure continuous provision of SRH supplies required to conduct the SRHR services are available at all times.



- Organize for and implement the roll out of the Comprehensive Sexuality Education Framework in target locations.
- Maintain a good record keeping system and undertake continuous monitoring and regular evaluation of the project activities.
- Represent IHO's Program in the State, County and other actors to ensure all program activities are carried out with their collaboration.
- Collaborate with the state and county to identify and roll out a boma health initiative strategy.
- Distribution of IEC materials focusing on HIV/AIDS, GBV & SRHR information.
- Using the existing Peer educators and boma Health workers support the to conduct health promotion outreach and sensitization activities to promote uptake of SRHR services using messages approved by the Ministry of Health (MoH).
- Coordinate with the local authorities to facilitate the monthly/quarterly/ partner meetings at county level.
- Plan and coordinate trainings for structures; CSE, FP, Peer educators and leaders on HIV responsibilities, SRH and support the respective meetings.

Operations.

- Spearhead monitoring and ensure the proper usage of reproductive health and family planning program supplies at the target Centers.
- Participate in annual program planning process, budget implementation, and recommend budget revisions to ensure smooth implementation of the project.

Communication and Reporting

- Submit reports regularly as required, information to program officer on program related activities - Submit weekly, monthly and Quarterly activity reports to Programs Officer.
- Maintain proper records for all correspondences of the project.
- Responsible for sharing minutes for all relevant official meetings held in the field.

Monitoring, Evaluation and Budgeting

- Provide regular feedback to the Programs Officer on project implementation.
- Assist in the preparation of the donor reports and project reports.
- Participate in the development of program work plans and reviewing them monthly with the Programs Officer.
- Ensure and maintain accurate use of budget lines according to donor regulations.
- Perform other relevant duties as assigned (of a similar nature or related and in the interest of the organization)

- Three years working experience in Primary Health Care settings.
- Working with district health teams, health facility staff and community-based groups such as BHWs.
- Previous work with an NGO in similar programs.
- Good experience in monitoring and evaluation of programs.
- Good report writing skills.
- A good command of both written and spoken English.
