Introduction

Position: Obstetric and Gynecologist

Based Location: Nimule

Number of positions: One (1)

Duration: Six (6) months

Reporting Line:

The Obstetrics and Gynaecologist reports directly to the Area Coordinator base in Torit

Purpose of the position:

The Specialist will oversee the hospital department in which he/she is a specialist and will manage all matters related to the department and be a member of the Hospital Technical management Team and support the state to build the capacity of health care workers in the hospital and other hospitals in the state.





Duties and Responsibilities

- Ensure medical services of high and consistent quality in the departments.
- Take charge of and ensure all supplies and equipment are available.
- Participate and provide input in the Senior Management meetings of the hospital and ensure the departments concerns and issues raised are dealt with.
- Participate in grand rounds and CMEs for the facility staff and ensure that the capacity of the staff in the department is improved to improve quality of care.
- Monitor the activities of the department; both technically and administratively while ensuring high quality services are rendered. Ensure to represent the department in various inter-departmental meetings.
- Assist in any administrative tasks at the hospital if delegated by the hospital medical director
- Participate in the hospital quality review and audit sessions and organize departmental audit and review meetings. Submit a report of findings to the Medical Director and Area Coordinator.
- Adhere to, supervise, enforce that all department staff maintain all medical safety procedures and apply the highest hygienic standards
- Remains accountable for the overall performance of the department and ensures that staff operating in the department are equally accountable for their time and services.
- Plan and ensure adequate (24 hour including night shifts) coverage of the department
- Performing additional tasks or duties as assigned during the period of employment

Key qualification and competencies

- Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery from a recognized University by the Government of South Sudan or in your Country of origin.
- Master's degree in an obstetrics and gynaecology from a recognised university
- Ability to plan and facilitate clinical trainings and grand rounds on a regular basis (daily or weekly depending on staffing levels at the department)
- A good understanding and working relations with County Health Officials, State Ministry Officials, Donors and Un agencies
- Should understand the working environment in South Sudan hospitals mostly from experience
- Ability to work in resource constrained regions.
- Must have the ability to effectively communicate orally and in writing.
- Ability to generate departmental reports (both narrative and analysed data)
