The M&E Officer will be responsible for supporting the planning, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of project activities to ensure effectiveness, efficiency, and accountability. The role ensures that the project adheres to quality standards and delivers results in alignment with the project's objectives.

Key Responsibilities:

Monitoring and Data Collection:

- o Develop and maintain M&E systems to track project progress against objectives.
- Design tools and methodologies for data collection, including surveys, interviews, and focus groups.
