As an RTI international staff, the Clinical supervisor is responsible for overall project performance to client requirements and satisfaction, and in conformance with RTI policies, procedures, and guidelines, working closely with the COP and Technical team to ensure technical and operational management and quality control. Specific responsibilities

- Under the supervision of the Clinical Program Manager, provide necessary technical assistance to guide planning and implementation of prevention, care, and treatment activities in support of the SSPDF HIV Secretariat in Juba Military Hospital and New Site Clinic.
- Provide Technical Assistance and oversight on initiation and continuity of Voluntary Male Medical Circumcision (VMMC) services and all related activities in Juba Military Hospital
- Participate in commodity forecasting and distribution to avoid stock outs and program
- Participate in conducting training, technical assistance, technical support supervision and other quality assurance and quality improvement activities.
- Provide technical input in the design of interventions to link identified HIV clients to comprehensive care and treatment services and ensure treatment adherence.
- Take lead in implementation of HIV/TB comprehensive services in Juba Military Hospital and New Site Clinic.
- Provide guidance to contracted Civil Society Implementing partner (s) on HIV testing, treatment, and care, and lost to follow up activities.
- Support analysis and submission of monthly data reports on the program key indicators performance to the RTI M&E Officer based at the Juba Office.
- Participate in support field supervision visits to review progress and ensure quality assurance in line with national Ministry of Health and PEPFAR guidelines.

- Contribute to development of project work plans and progress reports.
- Assist SSPDF HIV Secretariat M&E Officers in analysis and review of quality program data and the generation of monthly reports.
- Assume care treatment and VMMC responsibilities of RTI focal point in Juba Military Hospital, to work in collaboration with the SSPDF Local leadership, HIV Secretariat team in Juba Military Hospital, and in close coordination with the RTI Juba Office.
- Assist with administrative duties as needed.

Minimum Required Education & Experience

- A minimum of Diploma in public health or clinical medicine with 3-5 years experience.
- Minimum of 3-5years of professional experience, in HIV programming specifically in HIV counseling and testing as well as linking patients to care and treatment.
- Minimum knowledge in VMMC as an approved key HIV preventive method.
- Proven competence working with diverse stakeholders, such as members of local government, military population, health workers, and local organizations and communities.
- Ability to organize and implement training, capacity-building, and skills transfer.
- Demonstrated knowledge, skills and abilities in the conducting various types of HTS e.g., PICT, VCT and modes of HTS programming e.g., facility-based, home-based and workplace-
- Experience in MOH supply chain management system, commodities and pharmaceutical projection forecasting and stock management through delivery notes and stocks cards.
- Ability to provide mentorship, supervision and on job training to facility staff.
- Pay attention to details, data quality and reporting cycles and timelines.
- Excellent computer skills: Word processing, spreadsheets. Report writing skills.
- Good interpersonal and communication skills in English and Juba Arabic.
