



JOB VACANCY: FSL Project Officers (4)

Duty Station: Magwi County; One (1)Torit County; Two (2)Torit and Lopa; One (1) Starting Date: The contract will start ONLY UPON PROJECT AND BUDGET APPROVAL.

Aim of the position:

The Agriculture Extension Worker will technically support AVSI Foundation Food Security and Livelihood (FSL) activities and especially the planning, organization and implementation of the targeted goals and Objectives of FSL projects, the planning and organization of Monitoring activities and technical trainings and providing on job training to the Agriculture community facilitators.

Job Description:

- Ensure that Agriculture and Food Security outputs meet project objectives and are aligned with International best practice and consider cross cutting issues such as gender and sustainability;
- Ensures selection of beneficiary households within the target areas are following the approved beneficiary selection criteria.
- Take lead during distribution of emergency livelihood kits and share the reports on weekly basis to the project manager.
- Establishment and monitor of veg/crop groups and demo plots/APFS, in coordination with the CAD, as per project requirements and continuous follow up;
- Responsible for all the activities undertaking in the demonstration/production gardens especially the Seed production for market,crop production for market and value addition,tree-planting and agro-forestry,vegetable production for market groups by the extension workers and the farmers groups.



- Collaborate/facilitate in the on-job training in Extension assistants and Food Security Assistants, and support project implementation for community groups.
- Perform any other project activity that may be assigned to you by your supervisors from
- Produce reports on project activities and others as requested.
- Ensure correct and complete documentation is provided from activities.
- Constructively participate to project review and planning, review of progress of project objectives and targets in collaboration with supervising specialist and the team;
- Coordinate with relevant partners and stakeholders (Farmers group, County Agriculture Department, local authorities and ensure team spirit.
- Prepare and organise project activities such as trainings, building the capacity of farmers' organizations, conduct environmental and social frame work assessments, train farmer groups on group dynamics, post-harvest handling techniques and gender issues.
- Plan for project's day-to-day activities as indicated in the projects documents and assigned by the Project Manager.
- Participate in the identification of the capacity needs of the farmers organisations (cooperatives and farmer groups) supported by the project.
- Coordinate with the AAPs, Local authorities, and all the relevant line ministries and the group members ensuring transparent project implementation.
- Organise and provide framings to Established Farmes groups and beneficiaries in all agricultural aspects (CSA, Value Addition(VA), VSLA, agro-forestry, Input Fair(ITF), ERLP, and Livestock trade fair(LTF), market linkages and others).
- Develop TORs and train, mentor and follow up the VSLA groups in all the targeted
- Conduct FGD, ESF and community dialogues on GBV risk and sexual abuse and get to the coping mechanisms and community mitigation measures.

Essential requirements

Education

- A diploma in Agriculture, Agro-business, horticulture or any other related field. Agriculture technical and social training is an advanges.
- A degree in agricultural related course is an added advantage

Work experience

- At least 2-3 years of professional experience
- Previous experience with AVSI will be considered as a relevant added advantage
- Previous experience in FSL projects including inputs trading fairs, APFS/FFS and inputs distribution will be considered a strongly added advantage
- Experience with community involvement in implementation of programs
- Knowledge in agronomy, livestock production, horticulture

Required skills and experiences:

- Technical skills in implementing voucher fairs.
- Technical expertise in distribution of agricultural kits.



- Have experience in community mobilization.
- Technical skills in VSLA group establishment at an initial stage and monitoring.
- Technical skills in conducting farmers field school training and setting of demo plots.
- Extensive experience in computer (word, excel, powerpoint) and report writing skills.
- Have high spirit of interpersonal and team work.
- Have strong individual initiative and willingness to work extra hours with minimum or no supervision.
