Organizational Background

International Medical Corps is a global, humanitarian, nonprofit organization dedicated to saving lives and relieving suffering through health care training and relief and development programs.

Established in 1984 by volunteer doctors and nurses, International Medical Corps is a private, voluntary, nonpolitical, nonsectarian organization. Its mission is to improve the quality of life through health interventions and related activities that build local capacity in underserved communities worldwide. By offering training and health care to local populations and medical assistance to people at highest risk, and with the flexibility to respond rapidly to emergency situations, International Medical Corps rehabilitates devastated health care systems and helps bring them back to self-reliance.

Main responsibilities

- Provide care for patient before, during and after surgery or any procedure or by performing patient assessment, preparing patient for anesthesia,
- Administer and maintain anesthesia to ensure proper sedation and pain management,



- Oversee patient's recovery from anesthesia and caring for the patient's immediate post-operative needs,
- Administer post-anesthesia medication or fluids to support the patient's cardiovascular systems,
- Perform pre-anesthetic screenings, including physical evaluation and patient interviews and document the results,
- Evaluate patient's post-anesthetic or post-surgical responses, taking appropriate corrective actions or requesting consultation if complication occur,
- Manage patient's airway or pulmonary status using techniques such as endotracheal intubation, mechanical ventilation, pharmacological support, respiratory therapy and extubation,
- Monitor patient's responses including skin color, pupil dilation, pulse, heart rate, blood pressure and respiration, ventilation or urine output using invasive and noninvasive techniques,
- Perform or manage anesthetic techniques such local, spinal, epidural, caudal, nerve blocks and intravenous blocks,
- Obtain informed consent from patients for anesthetic procedures and select, prepare, or use equipment, monitors, supplies or drugs for the administration of anesthetics,
- Calibrate and test anesthesia equipment,
- Maintain a positive working relationship with clients, colleagues and community and embrace professionalism, teamwork, integrity, and medical work ethics and
- Undertake any other activities provided by the supervisor.

Qualifications required:

Certified registered nurse anesthetist, Diploma, or certificate in nursing from a recognized health training institution with 2 to 3 years work experience will be considered.

Experience required:

Minimum of 2 years work experience in anesthesiology nurse with NGOs or public health institutions.

Other job requirements:

- High computer literacy level with expected proficiency in words, excel and internet.
- Ability to work independently in high-risk environment with no internet or telephone communication and able to take personal initiative and multitask including strong facilitation skills in an ever changing and extreme environment,
- Extremely flexible with interpersonal skills and can cope with stressful situations and frustrations,

- Excellent written and verbal communication skills

Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse:

- Actively promote PSEA (Prevention of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse) standards within IMC and amongst the beneficiaries served by IMC.

Compliance & Ethics:

Promotes and encourages a culture of compliance and ethics throughout International Medical Corps. As applicable to the position, maintains a clear understanding of International Medical Corps' and donor compliance and ethics standards and adheres to those standards. Conducts work with the highest level of integrity.

Ethical conduct for IMC staffs:

The International Medical Corps maintains a code of standards of conduct that shall govern the performances of its employees engaged in the award and administration of contracts. No employee, officer, or agent shall participate in the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported/ by donor funds if a real or apparent conflict of interest would be involved.
