Key Responsibilities

Procurement

Oversee and ensure quality control on procurement generated at the field level (local procurement) and serve as a focal point with Juba procurement team for national procurement.

Work together with sector managers in the implementation and monitoring of the project cycle

procurement plans, reviewed on a quarterly basis.

Review and prepare Log Packs created in Jonglei, including Request for Quotations, Comparative Bid Analysis, Purchase Orders and Contracts/Agreements.

Maintain a sound archiving system for original documentation at the field level, and liaise with finance

for processing payments.

Support the Project Support Manager (PSM) in establishing and maintaining sufficient storage capacity to adequately support Medair's project activities in Jonglei.

Transport and Fleet Management

Oversee the smooth operation of day-to-day transport functions in Medair's Jonglei base, including Medair's fleet and external land, water and air transport services.

Oversee the management of vehicles and ensure fuel and mileage consumption data is monitored and

captured at all times.

Organize and track all cargo movements between Medair's Juba base and Jonglei base, ensuring that an effective system is put in place for the transfer of material and goods; and support the team in the implementation of transport plans when required.

Asset and Equipment Management

Ensure that Medair's Jonglei assets are accounted for and recorded on Intranet and Portfolio as per Medair asset management procedures and policies, taking into consideration donor requirements.

Track and update SIM cards in liaison with Juba Logistics for consistent availability of satellite

communication equipment

Organize equipment servicing and maintenance and ensure good record keeping is maintained (vehicles, motorbikes, boats, generators, ACs, etc.). Base Setup and Base Support
