Purpose of the position:

The core responsibilities of this position are to take the lead in overall project management, implementation and coordination of the WV implementation component of the FORESITE (Food security & Resilience in Transitioning Environments) consortium project. Female candidates are encouraged to apply

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Provide leadership for the implementation, monitoring and reporting of FORESITE Project.
- Provide technical support and guidance on project activities (see Qualifications, below).
- Lead the proper planning, implementation, monitoring, and reporting of the project activities in its operational area.
- Prepare work plan, DIP, Cash flow, procurement plan for the project.
- Prepare and submit quality project report as per the report requirement of the project
- Build and maintain effective relationships with implementing partners, consortium partners and all other concerned stakeholders.
- Ensure gender equity and sensitivity in beneficiary selection and planning and execution of activities.
- Ensure the physical welfare, well-being, and professional development of staff directly assigned to the project through trainings and coaching.
- People Management – Management of project staff to ensure timely completion of activities
- Raise Procurement Requests with technical specifications; Liaise with Supply Chain Management, and oversee project related procurements to ensure timely expenditure of budget and implementation of activities.



- Monthly management of project expenditure, including monitoring of monthly Financial Reports, and overall budget management.
- Review on monthly expenditure to ensure accuracy and audit compliance, in collaboration with Finance Officer.
- Project reporting, and ensuring timely submission of all project reports (narrative, monitoring, financial, and others that may be required) to meet internal and external deadlines.
- Prepare and submit weekly / monthly project updates to Zonal Program Manager, based on data collected by project staff.

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience

- Degree in Rural Development, Agriculture/Food Security, or in a related field but with direct experience in resilience and/or food security and livelihood programming.
- Minimum 4 years with similar experience as project officer or 2 years as project manager/project coordinator in resilience and/or food security and livelihoods. Experience of working in Warrap is an added advantage.
- Knowledge and experience from among the following skill sets is desirable:
- Farmer Demonstration, environmental restoration including Farmer Managed Natural Regeneration, community-led participatory planning and DRR planning, women's economic empowerment and leadership development; savings groups/rural finance, local value chain development/market systems development; seed multiplication, horticulture, crop adaptive trials, post-harvest management, improved grain storage, community-led peacebuilding.
- Should be highly skilled in writing programmatic reports
- Excellent oral and written communication skills in English. Oral and written Arabic will be added advantage.
- Having demonstrated organizational, interpersonal and communication skills; organized, efficient, and able to meet deadlines
- Proficiency in using computer software e. g MS Windows, MS office programs and internet.
- Ability to work under pressure in unstable security and remote environment is an asset;
