CMMB has been working in South Sudan for over a decade providing a package of integrated health services to vulnerable populations through its Children And Mothers Partnerships (CHAMPS) program. CHAMPS focuses on redressing issues that affect the health and wellbeing of mothers, children and newborns. CMMB supports the Ministry of Health (MOH), working with other health partners, to provide a continuum of care through integrated health services (MNCH, nutrition, WASH, Child Protection and GBV) and health infrastructure strengthening at the community, facility, County and State levels. CMMB also supports Health Information System strengthening through accurate and timely electronic systems, reproducing, and disseminating health registers and training of SMOH data clerks.

**Job Summary**

The SSHARP Community Lead will provide project-wide guidance and expertise on all community-focused activities. In particular, s/he will be a primary source of technical support to SSHARP's community partners in both Western Equatoria and Central Equatoria states. S/he will support project priorities by ensuring community partners are implementing effectively and community-to-facility bi-directional links are in place and operational. S/he also contributes on-the-ground experiences and ideas to the project overall as a member of the core technical team.

**KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Act as the primary point of contact with SSHARP's community partners.
- Provide technical guidance and oversight to SSHARP's community partners.
- Support SSHARP's community partners in their development of annual workplans and, as needed, budgets etc.
- Lead CMMB's follow-up regarding implementation progress with corrective interventions where needed.





- Liaise with the Grants Manager to support partners in adhering to the conditions of their sub-grant from SSHARP.
- Advise health facilities engaging with SSHARP on how they can best link with community partners through designated staff.
- Coordinate with other members of SSHARP's technical team so all advice and support to partners and health facilities is synchronized and each part builds on the other for a more effective suite of advice and technical support interventions.

### **QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:**

- Diploma or Certificate in a community development-related field.
- Minimum five years of community development experience in the NGO sector.
- Demonstrated knowledge of best practice in community development and/or mobilization.
