Purpose of the Post

Major Duties and Responsibilities

Ensure profession of treatment and nursing care to children admitted with SAM with medical complications, Ensure documentation of patient records and monitoring treatment progress, Ensure health and nutritional education is given to the care takers in the stabilization center, Ensure integration of treatment of acute malnutrition into the existing MOH guidelines, Identify training needs of staff and advices on the supervision accordingly, Ensure proper management of supplies, monitor and report stock levels, Responsible for sharing activity success story as per the project documents with his/her line manager.
