Main Purpose

Implement Health Promotion/IEC (Information, Education, Communication) activities with patients and local population to raise their knowledge and skills on relevant medical topics.

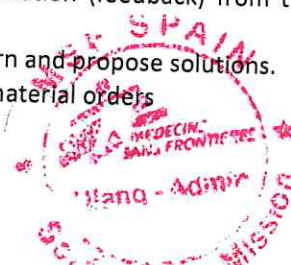
Main Duties & Responsibilities

- Inform patients and communities about MSF and services it provides.
- According to medical priorities, deliver information to the patients and community on specific health topics.
- Implement activities of health education and awareness (sessions in schools, churches, community), under the indications and supervision of the HP Supervisor.
- Under the guide of HP Supervisor, assess the impact of activities (with questions, verifications, and behaviors observations), and report problems, success, and constraints to him/her.
- Collect all type of information related to specific health and living conditions of the population, in particular to identify the most vulnerable populations to target.
- Report to HP Supervisor: activities, problems met, strengths and constraints.
- For OCBA: Establish and maintain contacts with social partners, including other NGO's, governmental health services that can provide answers to social problems.
- For OCBA: Keep education and communication areas clean and tidy and professional materials available.
- For OCBA: Participate in creation of any material needed for the activities of information, education and communication.

MSF Section/Context-Specific Accountabilities

- Support the HP supervisor in Monitoring community activities in Ulang and ensure the quality of CHW work in the community/DMC sites and MSF health facility.
- Inform patients and communities about MSF and services it provides.
- Provide health talks in the community either through CHWs or by giving them personally.
- Compile weekly/monthly data on community births, community deaths, MUAC surveillance, population movement and any other relevant health-related survey. Ensure Data is forwarded to HP supervisor on time to be cleaned and encoded into HMIS.
- Support HP supervisor in carrying out perception surveys or collect qualitative information (feedback) from the community and report it in the team meetings.
- Participate in weekly DMC/HP meetings: give feedback on results, share issues of concern and propose solutions.
- Assist HP Supervisor with the preparation of the monthly HP activity report/sitrep and material orders

- Collect data concerning blood donors, sensitize people on blood donation and participate in blood donation drive/campaigns.
- Communicate emergency messages to the community relating to epidemics and endemics, malaria, covid 19, cholera, diarrhea and other health-related issues.
- To assist in gathering relevant security information and making the links with various groups and actors to improve security analysis and management.
- Implement the covid 19 strategy and blood donation strategy in accordance with project needs.
- Participate creatively in strategy definition and planning of HP activities.
- To work closely with HP supervisor/managers and medical team to identify possibilities, needs and gaps where HP can intervene.

REQUIREMENTS

Diploma in social science, social communication, nurse, or teaching

It is necessary an internal MSF training on health messages.

Previous experience in teaching, nursing or social work, community mobilization (for OCBA, at least two years).

Local language essential (**Nuer**), mission language highly desirable (**English**)
