Job purpose: The medical logistician assistant will monitor and support the ordering, preparation and restocking replenishment of the Quick Run Bags (QRB) and PEP Kits, Emergency Response Team (ERT) First Aid Medical Kits and First Aid Kits in the (bases and vehicles) across the country program. All activities are carried out in line with Medair policies and procedures and according to any applicable donor, GSO-HQ or field guidelines.

Major duties:

- Maintain stock and act as focal person for First Aid Kits (base and vehicle), Quick Run Bags (QRB), and Post-Exposure Prophylaxis (PEP) kits and staff health stock for Medair SDS
- Process stock requests from Medair staff for replenishing QRB, PEP and First Aid Kits in a timely manner Prepare stock requests for vehicle first aid kits for Juba base, in consultation with Juba drivers
- Process stock requests, for eligible staff, for malaria prophylaxis ensuring stocks of malaria prophylaxis are maintained and ordered twice a year as necessary. with monthly checks (inventory and expiry dates)
- Manage the staff health medicines and medical stock at Juba warehouse, completing 6 month staff health medicines and medical supplies order, in consultation with Juba staff Health focal person
- Conduct monthly inventory for staff health medicines and medical stock
- And any other duties assigned by the Medical Logistician
