- Ability to coordinate activities with other agencies, build and maintain positive working relationships.
- Ability to understand complex security situation and advise program design accordingly.
- Possess ability to analyze information to develop a complete picture of security situations.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Security Officer will have the following duties and responsibilities:

- Develop and maintain relationships with diverse personnel who may impact security of MIHR personnel. These include, but are not limited to, local leaders, police, military, other NGOs, UN and government leaders.
- Liaise with other security managers of private companies, at the UN, the RSO, the PLSO, OSAC, NGO Security Forum, private and local security providers
- Assist in the development of Security RFP's/RFQs for private security contracts
- Supervise local guards
- Analyze open source and confidential information to continually update the national and local threat levels.
- Maintain up to date information on political, economic, and social status on national, state, county and local levels and report to the Chief of Party and MIHR's Global Security Manager.
- Provide pre-departure and post arrival security briefings to MIHR in country and international staff and consultants.
- Serve as the owner of the Country Safety and Security Plan (CSSP) providing updates on a regular basis.
- Serve as the owner and updating the Emergency Action Plan (EAP) as needed.
- Develop and maintain a Phone tree and Warden System to notify and track staff in cases of emergency.
- Conduct security risk assessment for MIHR's current and potential areas of operation
- Provide security briefings and training to staff. Provide all staffs with safety and awareness training. Recommend outside training as needed.
- Provide journey management support, including possible tracking systems and welfare check-ins for staff on travel. Co-sign all travel authorization and institute regular checkin (am/pm) when warranted.
- Develop an incident management system for tracking and reporting of incidents.
- Maintain disaster response plan, evacuation plan and other contingency plans as required.

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- Work closely with country and HQ leadership in advising on travel restrictions and program hibernations.
- Ensure all project vehicles have requisite safety equipment, staff abide by standard safety rules (i.e. seatbelts, etc.), and drivers receive in-service and ongoing training in security protocols.
- Provide relevant information to Corus' Senior Director of Global Security as needed.
- Serve as a key member of the in-country Incident Management Team (IMT).
- Any other duties as assigned
