In order to enable the tenderer to complete the forms (Tender submission form and Technical data form) electronically a copy of these documents can be forwarded in a PDF word format upon request. It is strictly forbidden to make alterations in the printed text. The tenderer will be bound to the original text in accordance with the document forwarded in PDF format or by letter.

A. Instructions to tenderers

In submitting a tender, the tenderer accepts in full and without restriction the special and general conditions governing this contract as the sole basis of this tendering procedure, whatever his own conditions of sale may be, which he hereby waives. Tenderers are expected to examine carefully and comply with all instructions, forms, contract provisions and specifications contained in this tender dossier. Failure to submit a tender containing all the required information and documentation within the deadline specified will lead to the rejection of the tender. No account can be taken of any reservation in the tender as regards the tender dossier; any reservation will result in the immediate rejection of the tender without further evaluation.

A.1. Scope of supply and related services:

The subject of the contract is the renovation of Pibor Peace Committee Hall in Pibor, Jonglei State.

a) Delivery and Project location:

The renovation works will be carried out in Pibor. The construction material will be delivered in the location specified above at Pibor Peace Committee Hall in Pibor town. The cost of materials transportation cost should be included in the financial proposal.

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b) Specifications:

Tenderers must comply fully with the requirements set out in the tender dossier (technical data form) and conform in all respects with the other instructions. Deviations from the specifications may be considered only if deemed to be in the best interest of the Contracting Authority.

A.2. General:

The renovation works will be for carried out under the MFA Frame project (11527).

A.3. Cost of Tender:

The tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of his/her tender and the Contracting Authority will in no case be responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tender process.

A.4. Clarification of tender documents and additional information:

Tenderers may submit questions in writing at the latest on the date specified in the timetable in article A.5., specifying the tender no. and the contract title. Information regarding interpretation of this Invitation to tender must be requested in writing to the Contracting Authority’s contact person.

Tenderers are not allowed to approach the Contracting Authority for oral clarification.

Any clarification of the tender dossier given by the Contracting Authority will be submitted to all tenderers at the latest on the date specified in the time table. If the Contracting Authority provides additional information on the tender dossier, such information will be sent in writing to all other prospective tenderers at the same time where this is practical.

Any prospective tenderer seeking to arrange individual meetings during the tender period with either the Contracting Authority and/or any other organisation with which the Contracting Authority is associated or linked may be excluded from the tender procedure.

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A.6. Eligibility and qualification requirements:

Tenderers shall in the Tender Submission Form attest that they meet the above eligibility criteria. If required by the Contracting Authority, the Tenderer which tender is accepted shall further provide evidence satisfactory to the Contracting Authority of its eligibility through certificates issued by competent authorities in its country of establishment or operation, or, if such certificates are not available, through a sworn statement.

Tenderers shall also be requested to certify that they comply with article 13. “Child Labour & Forced Labour” and article 14. “Mines” of the General Terms and Conditions for Supply Contracts.

To give evidence of their capability and adequate resources Tenderers shall provide the information and the documents requested in the Tender Dossier.

If the tenderer was selected through prequalification, the tenderer must only declare that he still conforms with the eligibility and qualification (selection) criteria applied in the course of that prequalification.

A.7. Exclusion from award of contracts

Contracts may not be awarded to tenderers who, during the procurement procedure:

- (a) are subject to conflict of interest
- (b) Are guilty of misrepresentation in supplying the information required as a condition of participation and eligibility in the tender procedure or fail to supply this information.
- (c) Perform, condone or tolerate corrupt, fraudulent, collusive or coercive practices, regardless of whether such practices can be attributed to this tender procedure;
- (d) Attempt to influence the evaluation committee in the process of examination, clarification, evaluation and comparison of tenders, to obtain information on how the procedure is progressing or to influence the Contracting Authority in its decision concerning the award of the contract.

A.8. Language of Tenders

The tenders, all correspondence and documents related to the tender exchanged by the tenderer and the Contracting Authority must be written in the language of the procedure which is English. Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the tenderer may be in local language.

A.9. Documents comprising of the Tender:

The Tenderer shall complete and submit the following documents with his tender:

- a) Tender submission form (annex 3) with supporting documents and other relevant information that should be made known to the Contracting Authority.

A.10. Price:

The price quoted by the tenderer shall not be subject to adjustments on any account except as otherwise provided in the conditions of the contract.

Tenderers must quote prices on one of the following bases:

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1. for construction material supplied locally, unit and overall prices must be quoted for delivery to the final place of destination and in accordance with the above conditions, including all domestic taxation applicable and sale including VAT;
2. For construction material to be imported into the country or state of the Beneficiary, unit and overall prices must be quoted for delivery to the place of destination and in accordance with the above conditions, including all duties and taxes applicable to their importation and VAT¹, from which they are exempt.)

3. DEFECTS LIABILITY PERIOD AND FINAL ACCEPTANCE

The defects liability period shall run for six months from the date of provisional acceptance. During that period, the Contractor shall be formally placed on notice by FCA to execute the works required under guarantee. In the event of refusal or non-compliance, the Client shall be automatically entitled to execute the work still to be done and to withhold from the Contractor's performance guarantee all sums necessary for reimbursement of the expenses incurred. Final acceptance shall be declared at the end of the defects liability period in the form of an official report sent to the Contractor. As such as the retention fee of 10% of the total sum shall be payable after six months after completion of the assignment (defect liability period) subject to the integrity of the works.

Prices shall be quoted in USD only.

A.11. Validity:

Tenders shall remain valid for a minimum period of 12 months after the tender closing date. In submitting the tender, the tenderer affirms that it is providing an irrevocable offer to provide the supplies for the duration stated.

A.12. Submission of tenders and closing date:

2. BACKGROUND

Finn Church Aid is a faith-based organization founded in 1947. FCA is the largest Finnish development cooperation organization and the second largest provider of humanitarian aid. FCA operates in around 15 countries in Asia, Africa and the Middle East. We work with the poorest people, regardless of their religious beliefs, ethnic background or political convictions. Our operation includes long-term development cooperation, humanitarian assistance and advocacy, and we operate around three thematic areas: Right to Quality Education, Right to Livelihoods and Right to Peace. Finn Church Aid is a member of ACT Alliance. Finn Church Aid is currently implementing a multi years project and 2021 is the final year of the three years project being implemented in Greater Pibor Administrative Area (GPAA) in Jonglei State.

4. JUSTIFICATION

FCA is implementing an MFA-Finland Funded Project *“Enhancing sustainable peace and intercommunal reconciliation in Greater Pibor Administrative Area of Jonglei State”*. The multiyear project seeks to support holistic conflict transformation processes and initiatives and facilitate the establishment/ strengthening of local peacebuilding structures and conflict resolution mechanisms. One of the key deliverables is to support the local government structures’ capacity to resolve conflicts and the renovation of the peace hall is a key deliverable in the capacity strengthening process. The Peace Hall will serve the local government, local communities, the local ICCs, and the traditional leaders to convene dialogue forums and peace conferences. This is substantially reduce the cost of continuous hiring of conference facilities.

Peace Hall, located in Pibor town was originally constructed by UNICEF in 2012 as Rub Hall to accommodate unaccompanied minors who were separated from their families as a result of the pro-tracted intercommunal conflicts. After all the children were re-united with their families, the facility remained vacant, and was handed over to the GPAA State Government. The state government converted the rub-hall into a peace conference facility, and different agencies have used the hall to facilitate peacebuilding activities, for example in 2016, FCA under this MFA-funded project an interstate peace conference between the then Boma and Jonglei states. The temporary roofing sheets have however been worn-out, or damaged hence requires rehabilitation.

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In 2019, the GPAA local government presented a request to FCA for the rehabilitation of the peace hall. Upon this background, FCA is seeking a competent contractor (individual or firm) to undertake the renovation of Pibor Peace Conference Hall measuring 47.86 x 17.68m as part of its local government capacity support and Peacebuilding efforts in Pibor. The Hall will be used for Peace Conferences, dialogues, and empower the peace committee members to gain skills and abilities in resolving conflicts in non-violent ways to foster social cohesion and peaceful co-existence.

5. PURPOSE OF THE CONTRACTOR:

FCA South Sudan is seeking to procure services of a professional contractor (individual or firm) to renovate the roof Pibor Peace Hall in Pibor County, GPAA

The purpose of the contractor is to carry out rehabilitation work of Pibor Peace Conference. Based on the technical specifications and drawings (see annex); the contractor will mobilize and demobilize all the materials including personnel required for the rehabilitation work and ensures that the conference Hall meet minimum safety standards (addressing internal, external, environmental and community level threats).

6. SCOPE OF THE WORK

Working closely with FCA’s Peacebuilding Advisor, whilst under direct support from the Team Leader for GPAA, the contractor will undertake the following duties:

- Site survey and physical site assessment of the damaged structures
- Develop a renovation plan for damaged structures (in USD ONLY)
- Provide costings for the renovations (detailed budget for civil works and services).
- (De)Mobilize resources and materials, and transport them to Pibor
- Identify sources of materials (from where the materials are procured/supplied in compliance with FCA’s DO No Harm policies)
- Deploy qualified and experienced personnel to complete the rehabilitation/renovation work.
- Carry out renovation Civil works including; Installation of super structure support posts; Roof Cladding and Roofing; and Earthen Drain Construction and Compaction. The detailed BOQs estimates based on technical generated specs for the renovation works is attached as Annex 1.

Note

It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to

- Carry out the physical verification of the site for assessing the scope of work; and
- Conduct the necessary tests to determine the design parameters.
- FCA shall provide camping space for the contractor at its Pibor compound for maximum 5 people
- The contractor is responsible for the insurance of its personnel and materials
- FCA GPAA Field Team Leader and R2P project assistant shall monitor the construction activities on a regular basis to ensure that quality standards and timelines are maintained.

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6. EXPECTED DELIVERABLES

- Inception Report to be submitted within 5 days from the date of signing the contract. The report details the work completion plan & assembling of materials, laborers, transportations etc.)
- A Final Work Completion Report in accordance with the technical specifications, design and drawing by 21 June 2021.
- Handover Certificate of the renovated facility to FCA.

7. TIMELINE AND SUGGESTED CONSULTANCY OUTLINE:

The assignment is proposed to be completed within a period of 30 days from the date of signing a contract. However, the contractor will have to develop a detailed plan (maximum 7 pages) indicating expected timelines in the technical proposal. The following is a proposed time line.

8. REQUIRED SKILLS, COMPETENCIES AND EXPERIENCE

The contractor MUST possess the following minimum technical Experience and Qualifications:

- Bachelor's Degree/ Diploma in Civil or Architectural engineering;
- At least 5 years of professional experience in similar works especially roof cladding;
- Authorization and Certification for preparation of designs by relevant institutions in the Republic of South Sudan
- The contractor should submit detailed references of similar works executed earlier (either as a firm or an individual), detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV) and qualification & experience certificates and letter of commitment of the proposed consulting engineers

For uniformity in evaluation, the qualification, experience record and technical fees of only the lead Engineer shall only be evaluated. Applicant shall be disqualified if the above requirements are not enclosed to the application.

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8. REPORTING

The Contractor reports to FCA team leader in Pibor at field level and ensure quality and timely delivery of the expected results. The contractor will submit a final report to Peace and Reconciliation advisor based in Juba at FCA's Country Office.
