Job Advertisement WASH Manager Leer County Project Site Relocatable Position



Job Purpose: Serve as lead technician for a range of different possible WASH options, borehole and hand dug well construction and rehabilitation, latrine and incinerator construction, or others.

I. Key Responsibilities

Technical Project Management:

- Act as team lead for construction, operation and maintenance of Medair WASH facilities in Leer.
- Develop and manage activity plans and BOQs for work in Leer.
- Contribute to the technical sections of proposals being written, budget and Gantt chart as requested.
- Selecting and instructing workers and supervising construction to ensure that it is as per the design, of good quality and completed to deadline and within budget.
- Plan the coming week's activities and submit monthly projections of cash need to WASH PM.
- Responsible for accurate and timely submission of internal reports and input to external reports to the WASH PM.
- Act as WASH PM during period of absence by WASH PM.

Security Management:

- Abide by and enforce agreed security procedures amongst WASH team members
- Pass on relevant security information and advice on security decision-making.
- Make immediate emergency field decisions regarding security when it is not possible to get in contact with the WASH PM/PSM/Project Coordinator/DCD/SFP.

Logistics:

- Coordinating delivery of items to site and preposition of essential supplies,
- Advice WASH PM on key / technical procurement decisions.
- In the absence of the WASH PM, sign off on WASH team expenses up to the agreed limit.

Staff management:

- Recruitment and management of assigned WASH staff in the Leer.
- Support the PM with Staff development and capacity building

Quality Management

- Draw / adapt existing designs for systems to be constructed.
- Seek for the continual improvement of both the technical implementation and the processes of the WASH programme and recommend same for implementation to WASH PM.

- Degree in civil or environmental engineering, ground water hydrology, or related fields with two years' experience or Diploma and three years' experience
- Practical experience of borehole, hand dug well construction and hand-pump repairs
- At least 2 years' humanitarian agency work experience in implementing water, sanitation and hygiene promotion projects.
- Excellent English (oral & written)
- At ease with Microsoft Office programmes including Word, Excel, Internet and e-mail writing.

- Knowledge of Participatory methodologies,
- Ability to speak Nuer or Arabic
