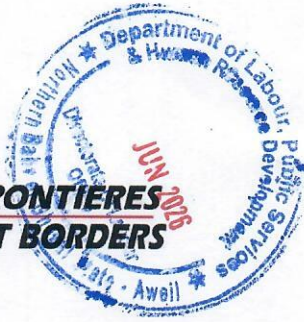

MSF-FRANCE JOB ADVERTISEMENT

Médecins Sans Frontières/Doctors without Borders (MSF), founded in 1971, is an international humanitarian aid organization that provides emergency medical assistance to populations in danger in more than 70 Countries.

Médecins Sans Frontières – France (MSF-F) is looking for highly motivated and enthusiastic candidate for the below position in Aweil Office.

POSITION: COMMUNITY HEALTH EDUCATOR-AWEIL

Purpose of position

Prepare, provide and present health education sessions to the population/patients according to MSF principles and values in order to promote health information through health measures and hygiene conditions as well as provide information about MSF activities in order to facilitate access to healthcare.

MAIN ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Accountabilities

- Prepare material and deliver health education sessions, messages and topics addressed to different populations regarding hygiene, diseases and prevention.
- Ensure all the patients and caretakers are well informed, according to protocols, about health-related issues and services provided.
- Monitor health situation and living conditions of the population by conducting nutritional screening, collecting information related to food security, checking vaccination status of children, looking actively for any defaulters in programs that require this type of research, collecting information on number of people arriving or leaving the community, births and deaths in the community, etc.
- Identify people with medical problems, contact with medical team and report for immediate transfer if needed. He/she has to inform to the line manager about any problem encountered (population, equipment, material...).
- Report to line manager of all results of screening and visits on a regular basis.

MSF Section/Context Specific Accountabilities

Since in Aweil MSF CHWs are Hospital based and the activities are mostly based on hospital related and community based are seperated.



Hospital-Based Responsibilities

- Health Promotion & Education: Delivering vital health messages on different topics e.g. health & hygiene, disease prevention (like malaria, cholera, measles or Hepatitis E), and the importance of vaccinations.
- Explaining the hospital protocols to the patients, caregivers and families.
- Triage Support: Assisting in outpatient departments (OPD) to help organize patient flow and identify the most urgent cases upon arrival
- Provide immunizations, prenatal and postnatal care education and promoting breastfeeding in maternity and neonatal wards
- Maintain confidentiality regarding all information observed or registered.
- Patient Advocacy & Translation: in emergency acting as a cultural and linguistic bridge between international medical staff and local patients to ensure treatment is understood and respected
- The CHW will give a weekly report to the HP supervisor on their activities (Health Education and other activities)
- CHWs should provide inputs and suggestions to HP Supervisor and HP manager by reporting challenges and suggesting programme changes and needs.
- Have good social and inter personal skills, Able to collaborate with local MoH staff, other NGOs and health actors
- Perform any other relevant tasks assigned by HP supervisors or HP manager as necessary
- Given that blood drives represent a core initiative for the hospital, CHWs are expected to maintain weekend availability to support these efforts.
- Try to build trust among patients and caregivers so that they can approach you for any type of information or guidance
- Maintain feedback system in the hospital so that it can help to improve the activities. If anything serious comes up share it with the concerned team or with your supervisor
- On working day, if you will be absent for something (important things, personal) , inform to your supervisor before 9am.
- Observe strict attendance protocols, ensuring any planned absences were communicated to supervisors by 9:00 AM.

Community-Based Responsibilities:

- Community engagement: one of the core activities of HPs to meet community leaders, payam leaders and chiefs to develop strong relationship and trust in terms of community engagement
- Health promotion and education: Educating communities on various health topics, including disease prevention, nutrition, hygiene, and the importance of seeking medical care. This can involve community health workers, awareness campaigns, and group sessions.
- Able to transfer health education knowledge and to recognize common diseases in his/her community, through attending the necessary trainings and guidance for accuracy of MSF
- lead sessions on health and hygiene, the importance of clean water, and the benefits of institutional deliveries (giving birth in a clinic).
- Report to line manager or medical team if there are people with medical problems, any difficulties that the CHWs might encounter during meetings with the population and any loss or damage of MSF materials and equipment
- Surveillance & Active Case Finding: They monitor their communities for disease outbreaks and "defaulters"—patients (such as those on TB or NCD treatment) who have stopped coming to the clinic
- Outbreak Monitoring: They conduct active case-finding for diseases like cholera, measles, and Hepatitis E. If they notice a cluster of symptoms in a village, they report it immediately to MSF medical teams.
- Social Mobilization: During mass vaccination campaigns (e.g. for cholera, malaria, measles etc), CHWs are responsible for informing the community and ensuring high turnout..
- To support in surveillance of communicable diseases and birth and mortality surveillance., and immediately report to HP Supervisor, NAM and PMR if communicable diseases or unusual number of deaths
- Data Collection: Reporting on community perceptions of sickness, food security levels, and living conditions to help MSF adapt its strategy.
- MSF Perform any other relevant tasks assigned by his/ her supervisors as necessary
