Background

UNH dedicates to implement humanitarian and development programs through supporting the National efforts in addressing South Sudan Health and Nutrition that pose Public Health threats. Within the integrated public health programming, UNH also mainstreamed cross cutting activities such as Gender based violence and protection.

UNH works in close collaboration with the Ministry of Health and would like to recruit registered nurses for emergency health project to be implemented in pibor targeting the IDPs and host communities. Applicants should be in alignment with UNH values of Respect, Dignity, Accountability, Impartiality and Professionalism and its vision of improving the quality of lives of people affected by poverty and disasters.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Perform and oversee the day-to-day management responsibilities as a Nurse for the Program.
- Support the clinical officer in consulting patients and prescribing medicines based on MOH guidelines.
- Provide nursing care for the patients by ensuring complete timely assessments including physiological, psychological, developmental, and sociocultural factors.
- Provide ANC, Postnatal and Family Planning services at the clinic and in the communities.
- Encourage and refers mothers to nearest BEmONC centers to ensure institutional deliveries
- Support and conduct community birth deliveries
- Ensure medical equipment's are handled with maximum care and maintain a smooth handover.
- Make weekly drug orders for the health post and monitor the consumption.
- Participate in screening of children for sign of acute malnutrition and implementing of CMAM protocols.

- Attend to and manage patients as per the MOH South Sudan /UNICEF/WHO guidelines and protocols.
- Inform or call the Clinical Officer immediately in case of a patient's problem that can't be solved at his/her level.
- Ensure full, correct and legible patient data is registered and maintained.
- Ensure health education is undertaken and health informative materials are available and accessible to all clinic attendees.
- Undertake day-to-day clinical duties, e.g. walk-in clinic, emergencies and periodic medical examinations, immunizations, etc.
- Produce timely weekly and monthly epidemiological reports using MOH standardized forms.
- Support in surveillance of epidemic-prone diseases and reporting accordingly.
- Perform any other duties assigned to by his/her supervisor.

Key Qualifications:

- Undergraduate diploma in Nursing or its equivalent;
- Certificate in BEmONC will be a plus;
- Experience / proven record of having worked in the maternity ward, EPI, Nutrition and pediatric ward as a nurse for at least 3 years in emergency situations;
- At least 3 years of work as senior nursing officer;
