OVERVIEW OF THE POSITION AND KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The selected candidate will have to provide a high standard of hygiene and cleanness throughout the guesthouse and the premises by ensuring deep cleaning of the accommodations, the outside areas and by keeping all areas neat and tidy.

Key responsibilities:

- Always ensure the interior of the guesthouse are clean by sweeping, mopping, dusting, etc.
- Prepares/lays beds daily.
- Ensures that the toilets and bathrooms of the guesthouse are kept very clean, floor and wall tiles mopped to maintain the tidiness - the highest degree of cleanliness will be required
- Ensure that all the bed sheets that have been used are washed, ironed, and packed for future use
- Clean windows and windows frames, glass partitions, and glass doors
- Maintain hygiene inside the guesthouse, kitchen, and the surrounding environment
- Carries out regular cleaning of the surrounding areas that are part of the premises.
- Dust all furniture and scrub surfaces clean (desks, side tables, bookshelves, filling cabinets, chairs)
- Empty trash bins and change plastic bags
- Ensure the daily collection of the building trash
- Ensures regular and adequate provision of consumables and cleaning materials
- Keep an updated tracker of all cleaning materials
- Identify and report possible repairs and burnt light fixtures
- Undertake any other duties as may be required from time to time
- Backup other cleaners' assignment in case of their absences
