#### Background:

Welthungerhilfe (WHH) has been working in today's South Sudan since the late 1990's. Since the country's independence in 2011, Welthungerhilfe has implemented 87 projects ranging from rapid disaster relief to reconstruction and long-term development cooperation projects with local partners, with an overall volume of over EUR 420 million. Through 19 projects in five states (Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Unity State, Western, Central and Eastern Equatoria), we supported 610,000 people in 2020 alone. Welthungerhilfe receives institutional grants from German federal funds (GFFO, BMZ, GIZ), UN (WFP, FAO, SSHF) and the European Trust Fund (EUTF). WHH SSD primary areas of work in South Sudan are food security, agriculture, food systems, nutrition, WASH and infrastructure rehabilitation, under the overarching umbrella of climate resilience and adaptation. Established in Germany in 1962 under FAO-led campaign against hunger, WHH currently operates in 36 countries globally.

#### Job purpose:

The Roving Field Coordinator supports South Sudan Program Implementation of emergency, recovery and development projects under the guidance of the Head of Program Implementation (HoPI). The position provides implementation support to WHH project locations to ensure there are no gaps in team management and leadership for adherence to Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs), workplans, objectives and expectations of various stakeholders. The position provides back-stopping support particularly during project startups, prolonged absence of the Head of Project (HoP) and during project closures to ensure timely execution of plans. The position is also assigned to maintaining mutually beneficial relations with various stakeholders including local authorities. UN agencies and other NGOs.

The Roving Field Coordinator reports to the Head of Program Implementation (HoPI) based in Juba.







# Key responsibilities:

- Provide leadership of project teams through a collaborative team approach towards project implementation to achieve success.
- Support the Head of Program Implementation in identifying needs, gaps, ideas, risks and opportunities relating to innovation in various projects and incorporate them in project planning and implementation systems.
- Provide project implementation back-stopping support to Head of Projects, Deputy Head of Projects and Field Coordinators.
- Participate in project kick-offs, monthly reviews and project closeout processes.
- Contribute to the development of follow-on and or new projects concepts and proposals.
- Represent WHH towards external parties (donors, cluster meetings, other NGOs) in support of ensuring good linkages and strengthening relationships.
- Ensure development of procurement plans for Country Office managed projects and implement them through initiating WHH procurement procedures.
- Ensure compliance with local authority policies in terms of local recruitments, procurements and acceptable local norms.
- Represent WHH SSD at the joint donors visit in assigned Project locations, ensuring the visibility and compliance with the procedures are observed.
- Ensure that activities of assigned project are conducted in a way that manages the risks to personnel, premises and assets.

# Your profile:

- Relevant University degree in relevant field of study, e.g. Agribusiness, Agriculture, Development Studies or Disaster Management.
- Minimum 5 years progressive experience and proven record in designing and managing various humanitarian and/ or early recovery and/ or development projects in fragile contexts.
- Excellent record of working with various institutional donors.
