- Monitoring and evaluation of programs.
- Prepares requisition orders and donation certificates and ensure delivery and Monitors use of medical/pharmaceutical stocks and prepare the monthly medical orders.
- Monitors health emergencies in South Sudan and analyses the need for intervention as well as
 participates and supports the Health Department in the implementation of emergency response.
- Identifies relevant health interlocutors in the Ministry of Health, Military, and NGO's and aware of health activities in areas of ICRC operations.
- Participates in the collection and analysis of data from all facilities as required.
