Background:

Welthungerhilfe (WHH) has been working in today's South Sudan since the late 1990's. Since the country's independence in 2011, Welthungerhilfe has implemented 87 projects ranging from rapid disaster relief to reconstruction and long-term development cooperation projects with local partners, with an overall volume of over EUR 420 million. Through 19 projects in five states (Northern Bahr el Ghazal, Unity State, Western, Central and Eastern Equatoria), we supported 610,000 people in 2020 alone. Welthungerhilfe receives institutional grants from German federal funds (GFFO, BMZ, GIZ), UN (WFP, FAO, SSHF) and the European Trust Fund (EUTF). WHH SSD primary areas of work in South Sudan are food security, agriculture, food systems, nutrition, WASH and infrastructure rehabilitation, under the overarching umbrella of climate resilience and adaptation. Established in Germany in 1962 under FAO-led campaign against hunger, currently operates in 36 countries globally.

Project background:

Overall objective is to provide strategic overview in logistics to WHH's mission in South Sudan and support Head of Operations in reorganizing the Logistics Unit in a manner that enhances and improves efficiency for seamless WHH operations.

This is to be achieved by developing solutions to diverse and complex logistical challenges that may arise and/or hamper implementation of activities and also through collaboration between Head of Operations (HoO) and the Logistics Expert in coordination with various departments both in Country Office (CO) and Project locations.

- In cooperation with the WHH Head of Operations (HoO), provide direct support to and coordination of all logistics throughout South Sudan.
- Under the guidance of Head of Operations, lead logistics functions during opening of new office and/or guest house sites with special emphasis on set up and assets.
- Manage, monitor and report on all logistics processes, including supply planning custom clearance and shipping, warehousing, assets, fleet, as well as other logistics related procedures.
- In cooperation with the HoO, effectively synchronize logistics systems in the country and support their implementation and monitoring, in accordance with WHH policies.
- In cooperation with HoO, ensure that all warehousing systems and processes are implemented and followed in accordance with standard WHH procedures and systems.
- Ensure high level of warehouse management functions aiming at production of quality reports and documentation.
- Ensure updated and correct asset registers for all projects, following internal and donors rules and regulations; support and ensure unification of asset registers across all locations; develop a master asset register to be domiciled at CO.
- Ensure proper asset disposal procedures are being followed and implemented as per specific donor regulations (including WHH's regulations).
- Ensure timely transportation (via diverse modalities) of locally procured or imported items to respective field locations.
- Ensure timely custom clearance and tax exemption processes on imported goods/items.
- Ensure the cargo movement to and from CO is properly documented and coordinated.
