We are seeking a passionate and experienced Safe Spaces Project Officer to manage activities, scheduling, monitoring, and reporting at various safe spaces in Nimule, South Sudan. The Safe Spaces Project Officer will be responsible for creating a secure environment and overseeing comprehensive programs for adolescent girls, including academic coaching, health, life skills, and financial literacy.

- Ability to create and maintain a safe and inclusive environment.
- Strong organizational and multitasking abilities.
