Monitoring & Evaluation Support in South Sudan

MI in South Sudan

MI has been actively engaged in today's geographic area of South Sudan since 1996. Our current programming focuses on Central Equatoria and Western Bahr el Ghazal States. The main thematic sectors are Water, Sanitation & Hygiene (WASH), Food & Nutrition Security / Livelihoods (FNSL) and Health & Wellbeing, while always considering the Humanitarian Development Peace Nexus and the importance of social cohesion for a sustainable impact of our interventions.

Rationale

To temporarily fill a gap in its MEAL department, MI is currently looking for independent and competent support in the areas of assessment, evaluation and proposal development at their project locations in Juba and Yei. The relevant sectors include Health and FSL. At the same time, there is need for a holistic approach of developing and introducing new reporting formats and tools in close coordination with HQ, which are then to be mainstreamed across all South Sudan projects.

Scope of Work

The scope of work of this consultancy is to flexibly support the South Sudan program teams on MEAL related assignments. Those include, but are not limited to:

- Close coordination with Country Coordinator, Project Managers and HQ Program Manager to mutually agree on specific assignments and expected outcomes
- Leading an assessment on MHPSS awareness, availability of services and capacity building needs in different payams of Juba and Yei counties
- Developing a concept note for a German donor according to specific criteria and guidelines (ideally in German language)
- Conducting an endline study for a BMZ funded project in Juba, measuring values, impact and overall success of the intervention
- Supporting the program team in South Sudan in developing, reviewing and introducing new reporting formats and tools (monthly report, MOOT, CRM, M&E plans, indicator & activity trackers)

Deliverables

The consultant will produce the following deliverables:

- For each of the tasked assignments, the expected outcome deliverable will be agreed separately
- Reports as per specified requests and donor requirements

The reports and all gathered data will remain the property of Malteser International and will be used as deemed appropriate by Malteser International.

Time frame & Logistics

The consultancy is to be set up as a framework contract from 01.07.2024 with a flexible quota of 30 (thirty) working days in total, whereby the MI country office in Juba or the program team would request the consultant's support. Based on this framework contract, the individual tasks will be carried out and billed by the hour and by the day. If required, the consultant will receive logistical and administrative support from MI, including for travel arrangements in-country and accommodation on assignment-related trips to other locations.

Qualifications

The ideal candidate should possess the following profile:

- Work history in the humanitarian sphere, with explicit practical experience in MEAL (various sectors) and reporting to international donors
- Knowledge and experience with German donors, in particular Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and GIZ
- Knowledge of the humanitarian and development context of South Sudan
- Cross-cultural skills and excellent communication skills
- English language required, German desired, Arabic considered an asset
- Immediate availability in South Sudan, ideally based in Juba or Yei
