Job Title: VCT/TB Nurse (3 Positions)
Location: Maban County
Duration: 4.5 Months.
Reports to: Health Officer

Eligibility: South Sudan national only preferably from within Maban counties

Purpose: To reduce the mortality and morbidity of the vulnerable refugee population within Yusuf Batil camp. This position demands a dynamic individual with a demonstrated ability to achieve results in a demanding and fast paced environment.

Main duties:

- In collaboration with ART Clinician and other clinical staffs, ensure the provision of comprehensive, quality, evidence-based ART (including early initiation for the eligible and ready patients), PMTCT, TB/HIV co-management, care for HEI, management of malnutrition, FP integration, retention to care, treatment failure, MDR TB, etc.)
- Refill the regular medication for clients who do not need Doctor/Clinician attention and facilitate doctor consultation as needed.
- Provide HIV Testing and Counselling (VCT and PICT) services at facility and outreach (community) while maintaining highest level of confidentiality to mitigate victimization.
- Provide adherence counselling during initiation of ART and ongoing counselling for clients on ART
- Facilitate disclosure of HIV test result with designated clients family/ partner/ children or care takers
- Lead HEI program including registration and reporting



- Strengthen client referral and linkage, participate in MDAT and other relevant clinical team and follow-up of cases at Referral Hospital on weekly basis providing feedbacks as required.
- Ensure accurate and timely documentation and utilization of National ART recording and reporting formats- adhere to dateline of reporting (HTS, PMTCT, TB reports, pharmaceutical reports.
- Assist medical staff to compile weekly and monthly reports required by the Ministry of Health as well as UNHCR and provide to Clinical Officer in Charge or Health and Nutrition Officer.
- Assist with additional nursing type duties in relation to HIV/AIDS and TB as requested by the Health and Nutrition Officer/Clinical Officer in Charge.
- Perform and any other task assigned to by the supervisor.
- Quality Management
- Aiming to achieve the highest quality programming possible within the challenging context of South Sudan
- Ensure confidentiality at all course at all times
- Ensuring good hygiene standards are kept within all health facilities
- Upholding internal values at all times, both within and outside working hours. External Representation
- Representation in relevant meetings in South Sudan as requested
- Meeting with NGO partners/Donors, the CHD, local authorities and local partners as requested.
- Assist in dispensing and preparing stock requests as needed together with other staffs.
- Ensure all stocks of emergency medications and treatment room supplies required are in the clinic at all times or ensure that the Clinic In-Charge is aware of stock outs/monthly stock report.

Policy compliance – Mandatory Reporting Policy (MRP):

Ensure any violations of the RI Sexual Abuse and Exploitation Code of Conduct are reported to the Program Manager. The reporting of violations is an obligation on the part of all staff members. Assist where necessary in undertaking activities that aim to prevent the occurrence of sexual abuse and exploitation of beneficiaries by RI and other humanitarian workers

The role of the VCT/TB Nurse cannot be limited to the specific duties and tasks detailed herein. The success of the RI's humanitarian mission is the highest priority and all issues which arise must be addressed accordingly. Therefore, the midwife will be required to support in unforeseen issues and circumstances and remain flexible to perform other duties, as and when required by supervisor.

General Condition:

- Applicant must not be person who has bad record or has been convicted of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA), Sexual Harassment and Child abuse.
