Objective of the poste:	The Partner Coordinator is the overall responsible for the implementation of the CDRD project through the local partner and will coordinate and monitor all related activities in the project area together with the local partner. He/she may also be asked to act as link between Caritas Switzerland and other implementing partners of other projects, depending on the needs. In addition, he/she will be the main point of contact for the project stakeholders and will represent Caritas Switzerland at local and regional level.
