Job title: Food Security & Livelihood (FSL) Coordinator (1 position) re-advertised
Reporting to: Zonal Program Manager
Location: Malakal, South Sudan
Availability: As soon as possible

Purpose of the position:

The FSL coordinator is responsible for coordinating, consolidating, and ensuring smooth implementation of FSL programmers through support to the FSL teams and ensuring adherence to World Vision and donor guidelines and standards.

Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Coordinate the implementation of food security and livelihood projects/interventions in Upper Nile and link World Vision with the line government departments at County level.
- Implement the FSL activities according to WVSS strategy, as well as based on proposals, budgets and plans
- Develop documents guiding implementation such as cash flows, DIPs, ITTs and ensure they are used correctly to achieve project objectives;
- Ensure that training focusing on issues of improved dry land farming practices (good livestock and animal husbandry, pasture/rangeland/water resource management and agroforestry practices, irrigated farming) are conducted to the farmers and the staff/partners;
- Identify geographical areas of interest to the organization according to humanitarian needs and vulnerable population context.
- Develop appropriate targeting criteria and mechanisms to ensure the needs of identified vulnerable groups are met.

- Ensure technical guidance of programme implementation in multiple operational bases/field offices through regular field visits (30 to 50% of the time) and according to donors requirements and World Vision internal procedures and programme standards.
- Plan and implement food security and livelihood activities such as Assessments and surveillance interventions, Agro-sylvo-pastoral interventions, Cash based interventions, Food aid interventions, Income Generating Activities interventions and Research and innovative interventions to fight hunger.
- Ensure high quality reports are submitted in a timely manner and work closely with the FSL project Manager (international) to ensure reports meet donor requirements.
- To prepare monthly and quarterly progress reporting, evaluation and monitoring and weekly planning.
- To conduct project team coordination meeting on weekly and monthly basis as well attend the FSL clusters meeting and prepare weekly, monthly and quarterly reports to the FSL project Manager (international).
- Responsible for monitoring the impact of the project, support decision making and promote learning through documentation of best practices and follow up of necessary adjustment with close consultation with the FSL project Manager (international).
- To plan and follow the activities of the project with the team such as field assessments, market price monitoring, and distribution of livelihood inputs (agricultural seeds & tools), implementation of trainings for food production and development for livelihood activities
- Assist FSL Technical Specialist in developing and submitting Success Stories /Case-Studies and lessons-learnt based on the Agro-pastoralists/ Pastoralist Peri-Urban/ community/community groups activities;
- Ensure monitoring of food security and livelihood projects (field visit, regular programme monitoring, budget forecast, staff evaluation and planning, donors reports, monthly reports, etc.)
- Support the FSL Project manager to closely monitor and track the project budgetary expenditures as per cash flows.
- Implement compliance mechanisms at community level, ensuring audit recommendations are addressed fully and in a timely manner;
- In conjunction with Zonal Finance Manager, ensure grant/project compliance whereby project expenditures are reasonable, allocable, and prudent and spent in accordance with donor rules and regulations to ensure compliance with external audit.
- Coordinate with program, finance and administration staff to ensure operational systems are in place to support field activities

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Educational level required: must hold a minimum of BSc. degree in Agriculture-plant science/environmental science/rural development /Agricultural engineering and related fields.
- Technical Training qualifications in the area of agriculture, fisheries, pest control, food security, livelihood, /Sustainable Agriculture/, or other related field
- Self-initiative

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- Team work and analytical mind, Curious and flexible.
