

### **USAID-FUNDED SHEJEH SALAM**

Thank you to everyone who submitted questions related to our request for concept notes – RfCN\_DT001. This document serves to answer as many questions as possible, in some cases combining similar questions which were received.

#### Question I: What specific locations?

Answer: As written in the request for concept notes document – this opportunity is limited to the 13 counties listed there, with the only exception being grants that target one of those counties but also include a bordering county or counties in order to adequately address the issue being targeted.

#### Question 2: Can partners apply as a consortium?

Answer: No consortiums are not eligible at this time, as the grant mechanism does not allow for "sub-awards" being given from one partner to another. The exception is if the consortium is registered as a distinct entity, in which case it is eligible to apply in the name of the consortium.

#### Question 3: What is the target number of beneficiaries in the geographical regions?

This is for those submitting concept notes to determine. There is no "target" for this request for concept notes.

#### Question 4: What is the range for the size of the awards?

Any awards made are expected to be in the range from \$20,000 to \$100,000 USD – please forgive the typo in the original document. However, DT Global is not asking participants to submit a detailed budget as part of their submission, but rather just a list of those line items needed in order to complete the proposed activity. Final budgets will be determined through a co-design phase after initial concept notes are identified for further discussion.

# Question 5: Is the establishment of a radio station something that could be proposed related to objective 4?

Yes, this falls within the scope of the request for concept notes, and the objectives of the Shejeh Salam activity. However, note that construction activities are not supported under this call.

#### Question 6: Are NGO's eligible to apply?

Yes, South Sudanese NGOs are eligible to apply, but they must be "faith-based". Faith-based is defined in this case as "an organization whose values are based on faith, which has a mission based on social values linked to that faith."

#### Question 7: Can you have multiple objectives under a proposed activity, targeting the same county?

Yes, there is no limit on how many of Shejeh Salam's objectives may be targeted with a single activity.

#### Question 8: Do we need to register with DUNS now?

Yes, those submitting concept notes should register with DUNS prior to submitting. A DUNS number should take less than a week to receive upon registering. The link can be found in the request for concept notes document.

## Question 9: What does it mean that partners are limited to two submissions?

Any interested partner may submit two distinct concept notes if they so desire. If a partner submits more than that, anything after the first two reviewed will be disregarded.

#### Question 10: What percent of the budget is meant to cover administration?

Shejeh Salam does not have any rules or guidelines on this. Potential partners should realistically present what is needed to implement a proposed activity. This may include labor as well as any other budget items necessary for implementation.
Question II: Can we exceed the 4-page limit in order to include pictures and/or charts?
DT Global will accept if applicants choose to submit photos or charts as an annex, so long as the narrative concept note does not exceed the 4-page limit. If the narrative exceeds four pages, it will be disqualified automatically.
