A. Background

1. The United Nations World Food Programme is implementing a four-year (2020-2024) project; "Feeder roads to strengthen the livelihoods & resilience of rural communities – To improve food security of the target vulnerable populations in Northern and Western Bahr el Ghazal States and the Greater Upper Nile – South Sudan." The four-year project is implemented in Jue River County, Western Bahr El Ghazal, Aweil South, Aweil North and Aweil West in Northern Bahr El Ghazal. In the Greater Upper Nile, assessments are currently ongoing to ascertain the needs and specific locations in Akobo, Pibor, Pochalla, Uror, Rubkona and Nyirol counties.

Some of the funding is meant to strengthen the capacity of at least 15 Agribusinesses such as farmer organizations/Cooperatives, grain traders, artisans and Stockists/Agro-dealers and facilitate access to financial services and markets. Hence, WFP is seeking one competent organization to provide Enterprise Development services to the target groups in the three project locations (Western Bahr El Ghazal, Northern Bahr El Ghazal and the Greater Upper Nile), effective January 2022 until October 2024, subject to annual performance.

2. The WFP Country Office in the Republic of South Sudan seeks to register eligible companies interested in provision of the following goods and services for WFP in South Sudan.

B. The purpose of this EOI

3. The purpose of this request for EOI is to identify suppliers with verified technical and financial capacity to provide any of the goods and services to be added to WFP's roster of suppliers. Eligible suppliers shall be invited to participate in competitive bidding process whenever there is requirement.

C. Categories

4. SS2021.00366.EOI.1 provision of Enterprise Development services

Eligibility

5. Eligibility to participate in the registration will be determined by proof of legal capacity of the supplier in South Sudan or country of domicile, financial capacity proven by most recent two years' Audited Financial Statement, positive references from recent clients & minimum three (03) years' experience, and the company or its shareholders must not be under any sanctions, including United Nations Security Council.

Profile of the service provider

- a) A registered consultancy firm, agribusiness development organization or financial intermediary organization fully familiar with the South Sudan Context.
- b) Not less than five years' experience providing capacity building, training and strengthening of farmer groups and cooperatives in South Sudan or the East African region.
- c) Proven experience in providing coaching and mentoring in enterprise development, financial literacy and business development skills to those at the bottom of the pyramid.
- d) Experience in conducting capacity gap assessments of micro, small and medium Enterprises (MSME).
- e) Proven experience in designing and conducting capacity strengthening for MSMEs (includes farmer organizations/cooperatives).



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6. After the deadline for submission, WFP shall evaluate proposals received and notify eligible participants of the outcome of the evaluation.
