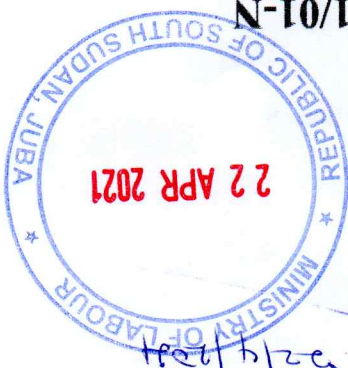

CIDO is looking for a suitable candidate to fill the position of Nutrition Officer for "Nutrition Right to Grow (R2G) " Project 2021-2025.

Job overview

The Nutrition Officer will manage grassroots advocacy on acute malnutrition with medical complications in line with the national guidelines. The nutrition Officer will play an advisory role for nutrition rehabilitation of the admitted children through treatment of medical complications associated with severe acute malnutrition (SAM) and prevention of further deterioration of the nutrition situation through community mobilization for behaviour change, promote access to provision of therapeutic feeds, routine and specialized medicines, promotion of optimal maternal infant and young child nutrition practices etc. the nutrition Officer will also be responsible for ensuring quality of services through capacity building and technical support to the SC nutrition assistants in the management of complications associated with SAM in line with the SC national protocol.

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Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Organize and conduct sub national stakeholders meetings on nutrition Advocacy
- Conduct nutrition and WASH needs assessment in the community
- community meetings conducted to share the findings of the needs assessment
- Formation and training of Water User Committees and support for Water User Committee meetings
- Training of CBOs and frontline workers on nutrition and WASH practices
- Formation and training of MtMSGs
- Conduct sessions with MtMSGs
- Formation and training of Men Group
- Conduct sessions with Men Group
- Training of local media on nutrition and WASH practices
- Support local media in developing scripts (socio-culturally tailored audio/video narratives) for mass communication on selected doable nutrition and WASH practices
- Develop and distribute locally and culturally tailored pictorial posters
- Organize and lead celebration of global nutrition and WASH events
- Organize exposure/Exchange visits in different counties
- Conduct KAP survey on nutrition and WASH practices
- Flexible to any other duty (s) that may be assigned by the supervisor
