To work closely with Zonal Programs and Project Managers to facilitate staff spiritual formation, church relations building, Faith & Development planning, and programs arrange and coordinate training, workshops, and conferences with staff, local churches, and partners for children's well-being and overall communicate World Vision's Christian ethos and demonstrate a quality of spiritual life exemplary to others.

### **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

#### **Coordination relations building:**

- Work with the zonal manager and F&D Coordinator to facilitate WVSS-local Church relations
- Represent WVSS F&D in Inter-Church Committee meetings and activities as directed by the coordinator
- Committed and an exemplary Christian with a life of prayer and a passion to work with staff spiritual formation and Church-related programs
- Work with the Zonal leader and Coordinator to ensure meaningful church (among other key partners) engagement in all key sectors and create new ways of Church empowerment

#### **Arrangement of training, workshops, and conferences:**

- Make all arrangements related to training, conferences, and workshops (CFC, EWV, WiTS, Peacebuilding, assessment, baselines, evaluations and work with concerned departments and partners to complete payment and wrap up all F&D related- events
- Ensure the smooth running of the Day of Prayer program



- Train and Facilitator F&D Models and approaches

#### **Bible study and sharing:**

- Lead field locations F&D committee and ensure their activism in their activities
- Facilitate the process of local Bible study, and talent day, among other spiritual formation events
- Plan and arrange all field meetings as needed by Faith and Development Coordinator, F&D council, or consultants
- Monitor the smooth running of bible-fellowship programs in all target field locations

- Actively participate in base worship and frequent monitoring visits in target locations
- In collaboration with F&D Coordinator be responsible for procurement and distribution of GIK and spiritual resource materials in target field locations

- Peacebuilding activities at the Zone
