Currently, CUAMM's operating areas are in Lakes and Western Equatoria States.

CUAMM is looking for a suitable candidate to fill the position of GESI Officer to be based in Rumbek, Lakes State.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Provide continuous technical support and guidance to health facilities, CHD and SMOH on gender mainstreaming, women empowerment and leadership skills, Clinical Management of Rape (CMR), disability identification using the Washington short set of questions on disability, identification and management of mental health conditions, identification and addressing other social inclusion gaps;
- Capacity building of health workers, CHD staff, SMOH staff, Health Facility Committees, BHWs and other CHWs through trainings, orientations, coaching and mentorship on gender mainstreaming, GBV prevention and response, Clinical Management of Rape (CMR), Disability inclusion and mental health identification and management.;
- Conduct supportive supervision to the health facilities to provide technical support on GESI interventions;
- Support the health facility committees to ensure female leadership;
- Coordinate with community health component (BHI) to ensure that community interventions reach out to women, girls, and other excluded groups and ensure negative social cultural gender norms are addressed;
- Support integration of GESI in all the health service delivery aspects including human resource for health, MNCH, EPI, Family Planning, Nutrition, IPC/WASH and BHI.
- Ensure dissemination of GESI related tools and guidelines including: GBV protocols, gender mainstreaming checklist, GESI IEC materials and handbooks to the health facilities as well as communities as work aids for health workers and BHWs and learning materials for communities.
- Ensure collection and reporting of quantitative and qualitative information on GESI related indicators, utilising the recommended data collection tools; document success stories and lessons learnt.



Qualifications

- Minimum: Degree in Registered Nursing from a recognized Health Training Institute.
- Relevant degree qualifications or equivalent experience relating to disability, gender, social development.
- Fluent English is a must, knowledge of local language is an asset
- Experience in reporting and data collection
