We are currently seeking qualified, experienced, dynamic, and highly motivated candidates for a Clinical Supervisor position based in Malual Chaat, Bor, South Sudan.

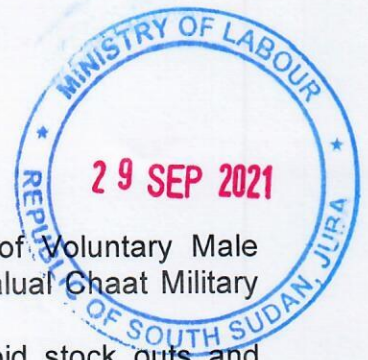
Description of position

As an RTI international staff, the Clinical supervisor is responsible for overall project performance to client requirements and satisfaction, and in conformance with RTI policies, procedures, and guidelines, working closely with the COP and Technical team to assure technical and operational management and quality control. The Clinical Supervisor will also perform other roles, as necessary.

Specific responsibilities

- Under the overall supervision of the Clinical Program Manager, lead the planning and implementation of HIV prevention, care, and treatment activities in support of the SSPDF HIV Secretariat in Malual Chaat Military Hospital.





- Provide Technical Assistance and oversight on continuity of Voluntary Male Medical Circumcision services and all related activities in Malual Chaat Military Hospital in Bor, Jonglei State.
- Participate in commodity forecasting and distribution to avoid stock outs and program disruptions.
- Participate in conducting training, technical assistance, technical support supervision and other quality assurance and quality improvement activities.
- Provide technical input in the design of interventions to link HIV+ persons identified to comprehensive care and treatment services and in ensuring treatment adherence.
- Take lead in implementation of HIV/TB comprehensive services in Malual Chaat Military Hospital.
- Provide guidance to contracted Civil Society Implementing partner (s) on HIV testing, treatment, and care, and Voluntary Medical Male Circumcision interventions to strengthen community engagement.
- Support analysis and submission of monthly data reports on key program performance indicators to the RTI M&E Team based at the Juba Office.
- Contribute to development of project work plans and quarterly progress performance reports.
- Assume responsibilities of RTI focal point in Malual Chaat to work in collaboration with the State MOH, SSPDF Local leadership and HIV Secretariat team in Malual Chaat while maintaining coordination with the RTI Juba Team.
- Assist with any other duties as directed by the supervisor

Minimum Required Education & Experience

- Masters degree and 3 years of experience or Bachelors Degree and 5 years of experience in relevant field (e.g. Clinical medicine, public health, Nursing, social science)
- Minimum of five years of professional experience, in HIV programming specifically in HIV counseling and testing as well as linking patients to care and treatment.
- Demonstrated experience in the various types of HTS e.g., PITC, VCT, Index client testing and modes of HTS programming e.g., facility-based, home-based, and workplace-based.
- Minimum knowledge in VMMC as an approved key HIV preventive method.
- Experience as a counselor trainer preferred.
- Proven competence working with diverse stakeholders, such as members of local government, military population, health workers, and local organizations and communities.
- Demonstrated ability to organize and implement training, capacity-building, and skills transfer.
- Demonstrated knowledge, skills and abilities in the conducting various types of HTS e.g., PITC, VCT and modes of HTS programming e.g., facility-based, home-based and workplace-based.



- Experience in MOH supply chain management system, commodities and pharmaceutical projection forecasting and stock management through delivery notes and stocks cards
- Ability to provide mentorship, supervision and on job training to facility staff.
- Ability to work effectively with SSPDF and government representatives, communities, and other stakeholders.
- Attention to details, data quality and reporting cycles and timelines.
- Excellent computer skills: Word processing, spreadsheets. Report writing skills.
- Good interpersonal and communication skills in English and Juba Arabic.
