JOB TITLE: Enhanced Adherence Counselor & community liaison (14)

LOCATION: Wau Teaching hospital, Maridi state hospital, Rumbek state hospital, Al Sabah children Hospital, Yei state hospital, Yirol state hospital, Mapourdit hospital.

DIRECT REPORT: Facility in Charge & HIV/AIDS focal Person.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Coordinates the overall adherence support within the hospital ART unit.
2. Supervise and support peer adherence supporters in the facility.
3. Coordinate monitoring of the facilities viral load monitoring service in the facility.
4. Leads the updating of client contacts, timely contact of clients with high viral load
5. Provide enhanced adherence counseling to clients with high viral load and those with suboptimal adherence to treatment.
6. Leads the implementation of appointment system in the facility including proper use of client held cards, appointment log, identification and tracking of missed appointment cases.
7. Coordinates implementation of routine quality morning health education.
8. Map community resources of support for clients on ART and facilitate client referral and linkage to these resources.
9. Coordinate linkage and client navigation services within the facility such as between HIV testing points and the ART unit.
10. Monitors HIV testing services with in the hospital and provide support to meet testing targets.

EDUCATION:

- Nurse with formal training in counseling, psychology, psychiatry or social work.
- Experience in counseling of people with HIV is preferred.

Desirable:

- Demonstrated knowledge and skills in counseling.
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Demonstrated ability to perform multiple tasks simultaneously
- Demonstrated experience and ability in meeting deadlines
- Good Microsoft applications and statistical software skill
