Background;

Water for South Sudan Foundation (WFSSF) is implementing a village-based Women's Empowerment

Project that includes a gender-based violence (GBV) education component targeting both women and men. The initiative aims to reduce the incidence of GBV by promoting awareness, rights education, and alternative conflict resolution approaches. The training will be interactive, culturally sensitive, and grounded in South Sudanese realities.

GBV Curriculum Development

To develop a comprehensive, participatory curriculum for GBV prevention training that addresses the needs of both women and men in rural South Sudanese communities. The curriculum should promote dialogue, challenge harmful norms, and equip participants with knowledge and tools to prevent GBV and seek justice.

Key Responsibilities;

The consultant will:

- Conduct a brief desk review of GBV materials relevant to South Sudan's context
- Consult with WFSSF staff and community representatives on the existing GBV issues
- Develop session plans, facilitator guides, and participant handouts
- Ensure curriculum includes:
 - o Women's rights under South Sudan law
 - o Justice-seeking pathways and support services (referral pathways)
 - o Conflict resolution and non-violent communication for men
 - o Cultural sensitivity and stigma reduction strategies
- Recommend delivery formats (e.g., small groups, role plays, storytelling)
- Propose a monitoring framework to assess learning outcomes

- Advanced degree in Gender Studies, Public Health, Education, or related field
- Proven experience in GBV curriculum development and training
- Familiarity with South Sudan's legal and cultural context
- Strong facilitation and participatory design skills
- Excellent writing and communication abilities
