



INTERNSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

PROGRAM SUMMARY:

Mercy Corps has been present in South Sudan since 1995 and acts on behalf of people who have become displaced and disenfranchised by the ongoing conflict. With funding from a multitude of donors including the United Nations (UN), USAID-Bureau of Humanitarian Assistance (BHA), UK Department for International Development (DFID - FCDO), Swiss Development Cooperation (SDC), and Private Foundations, Mercy Corps has been able to empower people to recover from crisis, build better lives and transform their communities for good. In 2020-21, Mercy Corps' interventions reached over 300,000 program participants in South Sudan through our work focusing on the delivery of timely humanitarian interventions, improving food security and livelihood options, increasing equitable access to safe water and sanitation services, and providing access to safe and protective learning spaces. With emphasis on conflict-affected youth, women, as well as IDPs and host communities, we champion and lead state-of-the art relief and recovery approaches through gender mainstreaming, identification of root causes, adaptive management, and resilience approaches. Currently, Mercy Corps is working in 7 counties in five states, implementing Programs both directly and in partnership with national and international NGOs.

1. Purpose of engagement

Mercy Corps South Sudan requests to engage an intern for 3 months to support program teams to align filing to Mercy Corps South Sudan policies, and to work closely with the gender team for country specific gender analysis and concept note development for pre-positioning for adolescent girls' program

2.1.1 Support the Director of Programs (DoP) in managing and coordinating support for program implementation in the field offices

2.1.2 Support updating of program filing in line with program management policies at Mercy Corps

2.1.3 Support strategic data collection for Gender and Inclusivity assessments supported by Regional Gender Advisor to complete MCSS gender analysis, and concept developments for adolescent girls programming.

2.1.4 Support communications activities for documenting success stories
