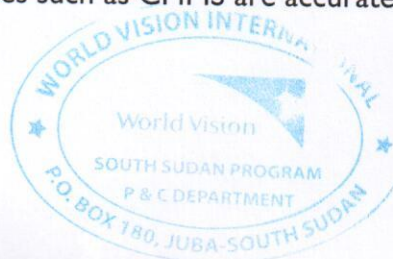
**Job title:** Senior Case Supervisor  
**Reporting to:** Protection Coordinator  
**Location:** Juba

### **Purpose of the position:**

This position is responsible for leadership and management of daily implementation of all activities at programme zone level. This includes the establishment of Child Friendly Spaces (CFS) in the required locations for the programming zone, ensuring all materials for daily operations of CFS are procured on time and on budget, CFS activities are set up and clearly communicated at community level, and daily activities take place according to CFS standards and the calendar of activities.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Lead in supervision and coaching of Child Protection Case Management to ensure high quality, timely, age and gender appropriate services are provided to adult and child survivors.
- Provide leadership to focused Psychosocial Support (PSS) programming as a service within Child Protection case management, including provision of capacity building, and practical coaching and supervision of Social Workers to provide high quality focused PSS. This includes development and/or review of focused PSS plans and activities.
- Conduct regular case reviews (i.e. weekly) with Social Workers to support the case management process and decision-making with respect to case plan implementation, review, follow up, closure / transfer.
- Take leadership of complex cases, or provide intensive support to a Social Worker with a complex case. Lead case conferences as necessary.
- Lead on all case management related information management, ensuring complete case files are safely and confidentiality maintained, and soft databases such as CPIMS are accurate, complete



and submitted/shared in a timely manner on a monthly basis.

- Weekly updates, monthly reporting to Protection Coordinator/Manager as required.
- Request activity cash advances and settle them in line with finance advance settlement policy.
- Request, organize / facilitate transportation of CFS, PSS, Case Management materials to the various field sites.
- Attend cluster coordination meetings at National or State levels when required.
- Do any other job delegated by the supervisor/manager

### **Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience**

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Diploma / Degree in Social Work, Psychology, Behavioral Studies, Counselling or similar required.
- Certificate courses in CP Case Management, Community-Based PSS, MHPSS coursework, focused PSS models.
- Work experience in Social Work, CP/GBV Case Management.
- Work experience should demonstrate experience in supervising the provision of case management, PSS or GBV response services; Demonstration of CP/GBV coaching and supervision strongly preferred.
- Additional experience in comprehensive child protection case management strongly preferred, or other work experience with child survivors.
- Must have strong working understanding of survivor-centered approaches, gender equality, respect for children' rights.
- Experience with use of CPIMS.
- Knowledge of humanitarian principles preferred.
- Must demonstrate patience, tolerance, problem solving, open-mindedness and interest in social justice.
- Works independently with minimum supervision.
- Excellent communication skills in English and Juba Arabic strongly preferred.
- Mature in faith.
