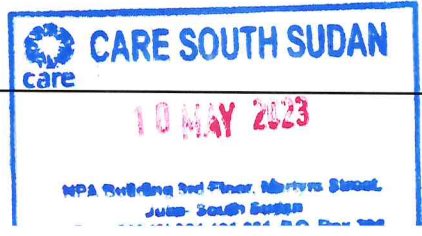

Job Summary

The radiologist will be part of Bor Hospital medical team and will use sophisticated equipment and computers to take images of patients’ bodies to diagnose diseases and conditions. This position holder keeps accurate records of repairs made and follows up with hospital administration on work performed or scheduled. This position provides training to clinical operators on the correct setup, calibration, and operation of patient care equipment. This position requires the incumbent to be on call during some evenings, weekends and holidays as needed, based upon assigned location and department needs. An understanding of physiology and medical terminology is necessary in order to communicate with clinical staff on a day-to-day basis. This position may be called upon to evaluate prototypes or new equipment (with little or no printed information available) to ensure the safety of patients and staff in the use and operation of various types of medical equipment

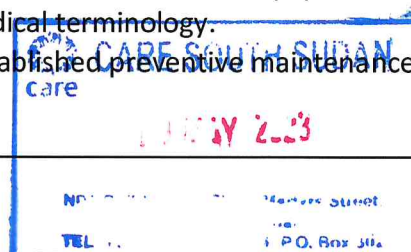
Responsibilities and Tasks



- Applying medical knowledge and skills in diagnostic imaging for diagnostic and treatment purposes and collaborating closely with the different departments of Bor Hospital to ensure correct referral justification for radiological exams and the results.
- Ensuring the implementation and monitoring of updated MoH diagnostic protocols and universal precautions in the radiology department.
- As an expert in diagnostic imaging, proposing strategies for departmental improvements and implementing them after validation of Operation and Imaging Advisors.
- Monitoring the proper functioning of the radiology department, equipment, and personnel.
- Developing resources for the mission, plan, evaluate, and supervise the training of the staff, in order to increase the knowledge required to ensure improved patient diagnosis and appropriate imaging referrals.
- Managing the team under his/her direct responsibility according to MoH HR management policies and procedures, supervising their performance, organizing, and scheduling shifts and rotations, directly participating in emergencies and on calls if necessary.
- Debriefing with Hospital administrator, Lot Manager and providing written reports on main findings, activities, conclusions and further recommendations.
- Evaluating patients' medical histories to ensure the various medical imaging procedures will not harm them.
- Suggesting alternative medical imaging techniques, when necessary.
- Informing patients about the medical imaging process.
- Using devices such as computer tomography (CT) scanners and magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) machines.
- Performing or directing radiology staff to carry out image-guided, diagnostic procedures.
- Working with radiology lab technicians to perfect image quality.
- Interpreting the results from diagnostic imaging procedures to determine diagnoses.
- Communicating and discussing results and diagnoses with physicians.
- Compiling written reports of results and diagnoses.
- Following medical protocols for resuscitation, bleeding, infection, or other emergency situations, when necessary.

Required Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in medical Radiography
- 3 years of working experience as radiologist in Hospital.
- Previous experience supporting Hospital-related equipment maintenance is an added advantage.
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work effectively and independently within a multi-cultural team with differing areas of expertise.
- Excellent analytical and writing skills in English, knowledge of Arabic will be an added advantage.
- Enthusiastic, flexible, and with the ability to work long hours.
- Ability to troubleshoot and repair failures in medical equipment.
- Thorough knowledge of sophisticated electronic test equipment and applications. Knowledge of physiological and medical terminology.
- Ability to understand and follow established preventive maintenance procedures.



- Basic knowledge of IT (Information Technology) terminology, setup, and configuration.
 - Proficient in general radiology techniques, including X-ray, MRI, and ultrasound.
