BACKGROUND

The International Rescue Committee as one of the world's largest humanitarian agencies, provides relief, rehabilitation, and post-conflict support to victims of oppression and violent conflict in 42 Countries. IRC is committed to bold leadership, innovation, and creative partnerships. South Sudan, an independent nation since 9th July 2011, is emerging from decades of brutal civil war rooted in disputes over religion, ethnicity, resources, governance, and self-determination. The security situation remains fragile, and the operational context is challenging. IRC has been in South Sudan since 1989 and currently operates in Northern Bahr El Ghazal, Lakes, Unity, and the Central Equatoria States. IRC South Sudan program is currently seeking qualified candidates to fill the above vacant position.

SCOPE OF WORK.

Under the supervision of the Environmental Health Coordinator, the Environmental Health Manager will be responsible for IRC WASH component in restoring and strengthening health services in Bentiu and Rubkona (Unity state) ensuring WASH intervention through health centers and Nutrition outreach within the two locations are in line with IRC and donor requirement. S/he will report to the Environmental Health coordinator and will work closely with other environmental health officers and Assistants and the IRC health and nutrition team in Bentiu and Rubkona to ensure efficient use of resources. S/he will provide leadership and technical support to the IRC WASH team in Borno and ensure all WASH projects are implemented within the standards and proposed project time frame.

- Ensure that WASH interventions are appropriately planned, adequately resourced, and implemented according to the IRC integration strategy for WASH and another sector in line with the IRC accountability guidelines.
- Ensure good internal and external coordination, communication, and team spirit with the WASH and Health teams across Rubkona County.
- Actively participate in internal and external coordination with relevant agencies to ensure project quality and avoid work duplication.
- Establish good relations and coordination with WASH and Health humanitarian actors in the target County where the IRC is addressing the WASH needs in health facilities and Nutrition outreach.
