## The policy should cover the following services:

### **Group Life and Personal Accident Insurance**

- Full time coverage (24 hours a day, 7 days a week)
- Payment of three times annual basic salary upon death
- Funeral expenses of minimum USD 2,500 per life
- Accidental death benefit of three times annual basic salary
- Permanent total disability benefit of three times annual basic salary
- Critical illness benefits of 30% of the Group Life sum. Assured up to a maximum of USD 75,000
- Accidental permanent total disability benefit of three times annual basic salary.
- Accidental temporary total disability benefit of maximum of 52 weekly basic salary
- Accidental medical expenses reimbursement up to USD 6,500 per employee.
- Free cover limit of USD 250,000
