Position Summary:

Reporting to the Learning and Knowledge Management specialist, the Backbone Coordination Team Lead (BBCTL) leads MELS' Juba and county level efforts to enhance collaboration between USAID Implementing Partners (IPs) for improved service delivery and results. Working with USAID IPs in Juba and in the 13 USAID/South Sudan target counties, the BBCTL helps facilitate IP-led initiatives to improve coordination of activities and build synergies.

This role requires deep understanding of the dynamic context and complex challenges facing IPs in South Sudan, and the ability to convene and facilitate policy dialogue in program design and work planning with stakeholders at national, state, and local levels.

This is Long-Term Technical Assistance (LTTA) position and candidates are subject to USAID approval. The anticipated start-date is October 17, 2022.

- Provide technical support and leadership in the design and implementation of Backbone Coordination services.

Qualifications:

At least a bachelor's degree in program management, international development, or related field. with a minimum of 5 years of experience in managing and implementing development projects in South Sudan is required. Graduate degree holders should possess a minimum of two years of experience in similar fields.

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- Demonstrable understanding of the South Sudanese social, cultural, political and economic landscape is essential.
- Experience in field-based service delivery in South Sudan a plus.
- Willingness and ability to travel to remote and challenging field locations required.
- Understanding of and commitment to field operational safety and security practices.
- Strong organizational, planning and group facilitation skills.
- Previous experience working with USAID or other donor-funded projects preferred.
- Understanding and ability to articulate the role of monitoring, evaluation, research and learning in development activities highly desirable.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Fluency in English is required; fluency in Juba Arabic, and other local language is preferred.
- Excellent critical thinking and analytical skills, including attention to detail.
- Excellent team player with ability to work collaboratively to meet tight deadlines.
- Demonstrable understanding of and commitment to ethical and professional best practices in international development.
