The purpose of this position is to, together with project coordinators, determine objectives of any construction and/or renovation proposals, produce designs and implementation plans and supervise the activities in various facilities across South Sudan supported by CORDAID to ensure affective and efficient delivery of all planned activities.

### **KEY RESPONSIBILITY**

- 1. Determines and prepares specifications for construction and/or renovation works based on the design, end user requirements, and performance standards.
- 2. Prepares bills of quantities where necessary and interprets drawings, specifications, and other documents.
- 3. Determines construction schedules based on the plan and specifications, and ensures quality work is delivered on time and in compliance with CORDAID and MoH and government policies and guidelines.
- 4. Maintains construction and/or renovation schedule by monitoring project progress, coordinating activities, and resolving problems.
- 5. Works with contractors, suppliers, and logistics manager to assess and approve materials supplied for construction and /or renovation activities.
- 6. Ensure the designs and plans for construction and /or construction works are clear and understood and implemented by contractors/site workers.
- 7. Prepares project status reports by collecting, analysing, and summarizing information and trends, recommending actions.
- 8. Maintains safe and clean working environment by enforcing procedures, rules, and regulations.
- 9. Maintains a project data base by writing, keeping and backing up data and reports.
- 10. Maintains CORDAID Organisational reputation by complying with its policies and practice with respect to protection, health and safety, equal opportunities and other relevant policies and procedures.
- 11. Contributes to team effort by accomplishing other related results as assigned by the line manager.
