Purpose of the Position:

TITI Foundation is part of the South Sudan START Hub, which focuses on localisation, particularly enabling funding and support to local leaders on the frontline of the multiple crises in country. We are tackling what we believe are the biggest systemic problems facing the sector: problems that include slow and reactive funding, centralised decision-making and an aversion to change, meaning people affected by crises around the world don't get the best help fast enough and unnecessary suffering results. In collaboration with the Hub and START Network UK we are running a Community-Led Innovation Programme in Kajo Keji, Central Equatoria State. This post will be responsible for the implementation of this programme including supporting the development and implementation of workplans, activities, budgets, reporting, compliance and safeguarding within a small team of staff and volunteers. This is a new style of programming which requires us to be adaptive, innovative and supportive of an entirely community-led approach to programming.

Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Support the coordination of programmatic, strategic and operational processes of the Innovation Programme in coordination with the wider team.
- Meet compliance requirements and support the writing of high quality reports and other ways of disseminating programme achievements.
- Work closely with the community in Kajo Keji to provide mentorship, guidance and support in an adaptive and empowering manner.
- Sustain positive relationships with local stakeholders including community leaders and programme participants to ensure collective engagement in the programme.







- Support the design of core content and activities that empower local community-led innovation to take place.
- Follow best practices, processes and methodologies in line with humanitarian standards.
- Support and facilitate workshops, sessions and meetings with programme participants.
