#### **Purpose of the position:**

Project Field Assistant also known as Project supervisor is a field-based position stationed at the county and working under the direct supervision of the Project Officer. The ultimate goal of this position is to support the CORE Group South Sudan Polio, GHS, WASH and MCH (immunization) interventions in Maridi County in the Western Equatoria States.

The incumbent will work with the County Health Department, Health Facility Staff, Project Field Monitor and Home Health Promoters to roll out quality program interventions, strengthen coordination, oversee project implementation, report project progress and any field challenges and make suggestions for quality improvements.

#### **AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

##### **Polio (AFP)**

- Support active case search for acute flaccid paralysis disease and other infectious diseases
- Support RCCE for VPD through house to house and visits and social places
- Support monthly supportive supervision to home health promoters
- Support weekly on-site mentorship visits to Home Health Promoters (HHPs)



### **Global Health Security (GHS)**

- Support RCCE for zoonotic diseases through house to house and visits and social places
- Support active case search for zoonotic diseases and other infectious diseases
- Support monthly supportive supervision to home health promoters
- Support weekly on-site mentorship visits to the HHPs

### **Routine immunization (RI)**

- Support Immunization In Practice (IIP) training to Vaccinators
- Tracking and referral of defaulters to the nearest vaccination sites
- Tracing and referral of new-borns to the nearest vaccination sites
- Tracing and referral of pregnant mothers to the nearest vaccination sites
- Support performance-based incentive for vaccinators
- Support last mile delivery of vaccine

### **Sanitation and hygiene**

- Training of home health promoters on IPC
- Support training of HPPs during training on hygiene promotion and sanitation (IPC) and CLTS
- Support orientation of community key informants on hygiene promotion key messages

#### **Minimum Qualification required:**

- Public health Officer, Clinical officer, Nurse, Midwife in recognized institution or certified Vaccinator and community health worker with Experiences
- Knowledgeable in public health, Routine immunization, community-based surveillance of active search and other community health related interventions, and skills in monitoring, evaluation and reporting. Must have basic computer skills in micro soft word, excel, and power point
- He/she frequently travel to the community and all project sites
- He or She must know to ride motor-bike and able to work in the remote areas.
- Fluent in English writing and oral communication.
- Juba and local languages will be added advantage
- Strong working understanding of Primary Health Care, Secondary Health Care and the Boma Health Initiative.
- Demonstrated application of Do No Harm, including understanding of intended and unintended consequences of gender equality and social inclusion interventions, and risk mitigation approaches.
- Excellent work experience in training facilitation and mentoring government staffs.
- Fluency in English language and the local languages spoken is an added advantage.
