Scope of the Position:

Generally, The Agriculture Advisor performs his/her duties independently with guidelines defined by the Project Manager, and in accordance with GIZ processes and rules or under the instruction of professionals in higher band.

Your Tasks

- Support in the overall planning and implementation of the agricultural activities.
- Liaise with the project team and support in the preparation of trainings, workshops, forums, team meeting, report writing and other project related activities and events.
- Support in designing and facilitation of context based agricultural trainings on agricultural production, horticultural production, Farmer Business School approach, nutritional counselling, postharvest losses, small livestock farming. agricultural marketing, and financial management through providing leadership

- to the project community-based extension workers.
- Liaise with implementing partners to create collaborative working relations and define clear channels of activities mainstreaming within ILiPS project and other sister projects.
- Represent GIZ in partner coordination forums and meetings in the state and at county level.
- Development of content: success stories, press release, presentations, and dissemination within the project and to relevant stakeholders.
- Provision of content and input for radio talk shows on agricultural subjects.

- With guidance from M&E Specialist, support M&E related activities such as beneficiaries' registration, data quality checking, safe storage, orienting community-based Extension Workers on use of M&E tools, data protection and basic M&E reporting.
- Provide support to Extension Workers by ensuring regular planning meetings, activities and context updates, report writing and verification as well as data storage.
- Regular provision of in-depth understanding of the farmer's needs, challenges, opportunities, and recommendations for management intervention. The technical professional will perform other duties as well at the request of the management.

- Bachelor's degree in agricultural science, agronomy, animal husbandry, agriculture extension, agribusiness, or any related field from reputable institution. MSc degree is an added advantage.
- At least 6 years of professional experience in food security, agricultural development, or livelihoods.
- Applicants must possess at least six years of experience in planning, implementing, and monitoring of development projects in South Sudan.

- Experience in working with international organizations will be an added benefit.
- Excellent knowledge of MS office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, MS Teams, and Outlook).
