Purpose of the position:

The Midwife's will contribute to the achievement of the strategic objective "reduction in under-5-mortality from maternal death, common childhood diseases and conditions (AWD, malaria, pneumonia) in health facilities and targeted communities in the county.

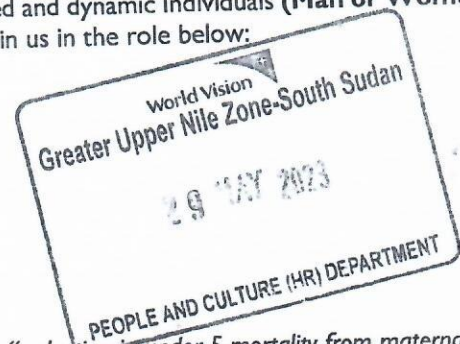
Major Roles and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the day to day management of Reproductive Health Services in the health in the Melut/Renk Hospital
- Conduct refresher training for Midwives, Nurses and other health facility staff on all aspects of Reproductive health
- Strengthen Maternal, New-born and Child Health activities in health facilities and at the community level
- Provide patient education on prevention of common causes of illness including STIs, improved IYCF and hygiene practices
- Compile weekly reproductive reports to be shared with the Ministry, World Vision and UNICEF
- Contribute to regular clinic team meetings and health and nutrition team meetings
- Ensure good hygiene standards are kept within all health facilities
- Ensure Infection Prevention and Control practices are implemented in the health facility
- Assist with other duties for which appropriate training has been received
- Ensure Infection Prevention and Control is maintained in health facilities
- The Midwife will line manage staff working under him/her in the reproductive health department
- Oversee stock management for supplies delivered in Health Facilities – either by World Vision, the (CHD) County Health Department or any other entity
- Perform other duties as required or as assigned by line manager

Qualifications: Education/Knowledge/Technical Skills and Experience:

The following may be acquired through a combination of formal or self-education, prior experience or on-the-job training:

- Must be a South Sudanese National



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- **Registered Midwife (Degree or Diploma)** from a recognized higher institution with significant years of experience in a similar role and license to practice in South Sudan
- Experience in training and capacity building of midwives and other health staff
- Ability to speak and write well in English
- Experience in computer use and ability to generate reports in excel and word
- In-depth knowledge of Prevention of Mother to Child Transmission of HIV (PMTCT), Emergency Obstetric and Newborn and Family Planning
- Experience in working with Adolescents and Young People
- Be a committed Christian who espouses Christian values throughout his/her work
- Highly organized, efficient, and able to meet key deadlines with proven analytical, problem-solving skills and comfortable working under minimal supervision
