Job Summary

The driver is expected to drive the allocated vehicle for approved trips during approved driving hours. He is responsible for maintenance, cleanliness and security of the vehicle as well as the safety of the cargo and the passengers in board. Must report the vehicle incident to the line manager immediately.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Drive Truck/bus for transportation of goods, refugee/returnees and other persons or cargo authorized by the office.
- Responsible to keep truck/bus including the light vehicles to the highest standard by observing the maintenance interval.
- Carries out daily inspection of the truck/bus on his custody before starting the engine, check leakages lubricant and water levels, check wheels and tighten all bolts and nut.
- Undertake minor repair/maintenance of the truck and always avoid idling and over speeding.

Ensure that any dysfunction in the truck/bus is immediately reported to the logistics/field officer.

Complete the truck's logbook correctly and conscientious in accordance with AAH-I and respected partners.

- Clean the interior and exterior of the trucks regularly. Such as before and after used/loading/offloading.
- Reports need for service, including minor accident, damage, loss or theft of fittings.
- Complying with security measure set ford by the office while working or during the operation.
- Respect speed limit while driving in the town and always to be on radio communication channel.
- Any non-authorized modification of truck's tachometer will result into termination, this applies also in case of truck's fuel stealing and none authorized cargo loading.
